NRHA Pattern 11



Horses must jog to the center of the arena (see Judges Guide for maneuver description). Horses must walk or stop prior to starting the pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1.Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.

2.Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

Beginning on the right led complete three circles to the right; the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.


4.Complete three circles to the left; the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.

5.Begin a large circle to the right, but do not close this circle. Run down the center of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.

6.Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback-no hesitation.

Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions Page 1 of 3

Jess: (*MH*)- Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs.

Grinder: (MH) Does all maneuvers well, needs to be pushed into bridle and supported to stops. Otherwise, he will front end his stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.

Bob (MH) - Reiner, Good Draw, Nice Rollback and Spins. NO SPURS. Has been around the block, don't run hard! Set up for $R \rightarrow L$ lead, in the lead change may drag hind lead.

River (Triple Edge): Arab Very willing to work. Can wear spurs but ok with none. Need to stay light in his mouth. Will collect with leg pressure. Is spur trained. For pattern work he will get nervous at the first cone but if you don't make him wait he is great for patterns. Just need to stay quite with him at the start for pattern work.Weight Horse #175

Rolf (Triple Edge) - Fjord Gelding, He is spur trained. Very easy will do what you ask him. Can keep him bridled but also ok on a looser rein. Height 5'7"

Tuffy - (McColley) Spurs needed, set up for right lead, leg release to stop, light contact, will jog and lope slow but you have to make him and it requires a lot of leg, responds to voice command. Requires leg contact at the lope. Can have contact if leg is there to back it up. Good Draw.

Cindi (McColley) – NO SPURS, soft legs, if you bang on her she will get hot easily especially during patterns. Must be light on her sides. Spur Trained, Light to medium contact, knowns verbal commands. Good Draw. Legs release/ Spur Stop. Legs on to back

Jake - (McColley) Spurs recommended, keep a soft leg, leg release stop, light to medium contact, responds to voice commands, do not use in patterns with spins. Don't trap him in reverse. Good Draw.

Charlie (McColley) - Light contact, leg release stop. Can be looky to the right, responds well to voice commands. NO SPURS

Lilly (KCPH) - (SATURDAY ONLY) Does have a spur spot and responds better with legs than hands. Light contact. Good Draw. Walk Trot Only. Ball Spurs allowed if not in a walk trot class.

Grace (KCPH) - (SATURDAY ONLY) May use spurs. Good Draw, squeeze legs to slow down. Spur Stop. Very light contact, as she likes her face. Good for leads, can job slow when asked.

Dusty (KCPH) (SATURDAY ONLY) Use spurs if allowed as he can get lazy. Light to no contact. Spur stop

Woody- (Hancock) App gelding. Good draw. Reiner type. Ride with light contact. NO SPURS. Use in higher levels Ruby and up good for patterns.

Kernal- (Hancock) Grulla QH. Ride quiet with seat legs and hands. Set up for leads. NO SPURS. Use in higher levels Ruby and up only rail.

Milo: (Hancock) Reiner, Use spurs allowed by your division. Will be good in walk/jog divisions without spurs. Overall consistent good draw.

Bree (Hancock) -Appaloosa Mare, Good Draw, Ball Spurs only. Good in Walk/jog classes without spurs. Set up for right lead. Very light rein contact. Don't bridle her up too tight!

Horse Descriptions Page 2 of 3

Chester- (Hancock) Chestnut Quarter Horse Gelding. Good draw. Stay relaxed on him. Can ride with light contact. Easy draw and great pattern horse. Squeeze to slow down and kiss to lope off. Talk to him when you stop and break down to trot or walk. Ball spurs preferred but can use rowel.

Remi- (Hancock) Sorrel Quarter Horse Mare. Good draw. Ride with light contact. Has a leg release stop. Set up for leads. Great pattern horse. To slow down release your legs off of her, but not so much she will stop. Do not squeeze to slow her down, it will make her go faster. Ball spurs only.

Diesel- (Hancock) good draw. Ride collected but not trapped. Division appropriate spurs, may need crop for walk trot check with horse provider. Set up for leads.

Annabelle- (Hancock) Haflinger Mare. Ride with two hands. Quiet smooth ride. NO SPURS.

Doc (Hancock) – Buckskin QH, Division Appropriate Spurs OK, Ranch Type, Ride with strong leg but don't over use spurs. Ride with light rein contact. Responds well to voice commands

Mister (Champion Hill) – Big Mover, go to bridle to slow, set up for leads has a flying lead. No Spurs

Hope (Champion Hill) – Consistent, Keep on the Rail always the same horse. Good with voice. Will start dropping her shoulder as day goes on. NO SPURS

Benny (Champion Hill) – Walk Trot Only. Lesson Horse. Ride in the bridle, responds well to voice commands. **Steward and paddock master or owner must be the one who changes the saddle or adjust the saddle (he bites at himself)!!!!!!!!** Weight restriction due to age. #175

Travis (Puthoff) Very Good Draw, No Spurs (may change to Ball Spurs later in the day, check with the steward.) Light legs, set up for leads. He knows lead changes. Once loping don't use much leg.

Dawg (Puthoff) Reiner & Horsemanship, Ball Spurs or Dull Spurs (Division Appropriate). LOTS of calf for lead changes. Can be used in Reining but don't chase for stops. Set up for Leads.

Zip (Puthoff) Quiet, Easy Draw. Ball Spurs or Dull Spurs (Division Appropriate). Lazy.

Chloe (Puthoff) Ball Spurs or Dull Spurs (Division Appropriate). Set up for leads, use leg!

EMMETT - (BayHill) sorrel gelding, can be lazy, spurs or crop.

DANNY - (BayHill) sorrel gelding, light contact. If you hold too tight he won't go forward. Set up for leads, spurs or a crop.

Bella: (Bayhill) Good Spins. Good lead changes. Will get restless in the middle so don't stand very long. she will get hot if you try to run her too hard.

GINGER - (BayHill) sorrel mare, great draw, light contact. Set up for leads, spurs or crop

Sly (BayHill) – Bay Gelding, set up for leads. Smooth lope and trot. Can go without spurs. Great Pattern Horse, Reiner Type.

Forrest: (Arnold) Light rein contact. Rowel or ball spur depending on division. Use hand and leg to support into lope transition and to collect on rail. Has spur stop for patterns.

Freddie: (Arnold) Good Draw! Loose rein easy ride ball spurs.

Gabby: (Arnold) Good Draw! Use light contact. Ball Spurs or No Spurs (Check with Steward)

Rocky: (Arnold) Light rein contact. No Spurs. May anticipate on patterns. Just don't rush him in transitions. No Spurs. Let horse holder put numbers in number holders HATES to have his flank area touched. Great to ride. Great Draw.

Sissy: (Arnold) Light rein contact. Support with hand and use leg to collect. Needs to be set up for right lead. Hand to rail and push hip in. Stay forward in turns for patterns. Ball Spurs Only

Melody - (EQD) Red Dun QH mare. Needs ridden with contact but not a lot of bit pressure. Support with leg for lope. Spurs needed for lope.

Sugar: (EQD) Buckskin QH Mare (EQD)- Use soft holding contact on her mouth. Can slow her bouncy trot by softening mouth. Set up for leads. Will go with or without spurs.

Nala (EQD) Solid Paint Maire, Really nice horse. She needs a little pushing at times so a crop is ok. She is spur broke. Needs set up for transitions. Will cut corners if the rider allows.

Dakota (EQD) Appaloosa gelding. Works really well off of seat and leg. Rider will need to maintain some soft contact on the bit and set up for transitions. Can get forward in transitions, bump on the bit will bring him back down. Can you spurs on him but he does well without.

Rawhide (Timmerman's) – (Wt Horse due to age #175) Older Horse, VERY QUIET! 16 hands tall. Great for walk/trot! No Spurs, No Crop!

Big Shot (Timmerman's) – 15' 3 hand gelding, steady eddie horse. Great Draw. Set up for right lead, turn head until he has picked up the lead. No Spurs, No Crop!

Squirt (Timmermans) Roping Horse, Older Horse, very quiet! Easy going, basic cues. Medium contact. 14'3" Height/Weight Horse 5'7" & 175# No Spurs, No Crop!

Handsome (Timmermans) Chestnut Morgan 14'3", Height Horse 5'7", Can have a higher head carriage, medium contact, can have a sticky right lead. Basic commands, no spur stop. No Spurs, No Crop!

Sassy - (M&M) basic Walk trot, medium Rein. Kick to go. Say easy and pull to walk 2 hands

jay (M&M) – Ranch Horse type, can go slow on the rail. Spurs Ok

Molly (M&M) Reiner - she has a lot of go. Spurs optional, probably not needed. Traditionally broke like a reiner, feet away to stop. Keep bridled with minimal contact. Lots of hand to leg connection. Very talented. Easy lead change. WIII not hesitate well in the middle for the reining. She is a cute Reiner at 13'3" so she is going to be a Height/Weight #175 and 5'7"

Shorty (Arthur) Height Weight Height/Weight #175 and 5'7" No spurs ride two-handed, ranch horse type ride with Light contact not a drape rain ride off the rail can get looky. Let her walk out at the walk, rider choose her speed for jog and lope, very sensitive, light leg and hands.

Manny (Arthur) Light contact on his face, protect his leads **<u>especially</u>** in patterns. Very light leg in patterns. Pull to slow down. Spur stop. Spurs in appropriate divisions rowels are fine. VERY GOOD DRAW

Gauge – (Grimm) Sorrel Quarter Horse gelding, Rommel Reins, Rowel and ball spurs ok. Use inside led to keep on the rail, kiss to lope, pull back and apply even leg pressure to back, can be more forward at the lope and slow at the jog but all gaits are smooth, set up for both leads. **Mya** – (Grimm) Black Quarter Pony Mare, 14.1 Hands, light to moderate rein contact, sit deep

and squeeze calf softly to slow, spur stop, hold spur or heel softly with equal pressure to back,

use soft voice commands (kiss to lope, verbally say trot, and back and walk softly while cueing with legs.) If you are good with spurs rowels are ok, if not ball spurs or no spurs will work.

YEDA will adhere to a very strict policy for the rest of YEDA show season <u>"No one can plug anything</u> <u>into any facility outlet"</u>. If a team or individual needs to plug in a truck, trailer or camper a hookup fee will be charged, which <u>must be paid ahead of time in the YEDA office</u>, once paid a permit will be given as <u>proof of purchase</u>. Hook up fees vary depending on location and charged per night. Generators are prohibited in and near the arena. You are welcome to bring a camper or horse trailer and park it in the camping area to house your generator and the items you plan to run off your generator. There will be a \$100 fine for generators outside designated areas or for plugging items in not in the camping area.

Many teams enjoy planning and bringing their team food to the shows and you can still do this but with a camper or trailer hook up fee and keep all your feasts appliances, crock pots, and food inside. 








Sapphire/Alumni Pattern 2









Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

 Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.

Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.

3.Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.

4.Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.

5.Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (threemeters). Hesitate.

6.Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

7..Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions Page 1 of 3

Jess: (*MH*)- Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs.

Grinder: (MH) Does all maneuvers well, needs to be pushed into bridle and supported to stops. Otherwise, he will front end his stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.

Bob (MH) - Reiner, Good Draw, Nice Rollback and Spins. NO SPURS. Has been around the block, don't run hard! Set up for $R \rightarrow L$ lead, in the lead change may drag hind lead.

River (Triple Edge): Arab Very willing to work. Can wear spurs but ok with none. Need to stay light in his mouth. Will collect with leg pressure. Is spur trained. For pattern work he will get nervous at the first cone but if you don't make him wait he is great for patterns. Just need to stay quite with him at the start for pattern work.Weight Horse #175

Rolf (Triple Edge) - Fjord Gelding, He is spur trained. Very easy will do what you ask him. Can keep him bridled but also ok on a looser rein. Height 5'7"

Tuffy - (McColley) Spurs needed, set up for right lead, leg release to stop, light contact, will jog and lope slow but you have to make him and it requires a lot of leg, responds to voice command. Requires leg contact at the lope. Can have contact if leg is there to back it up. Good Draw.

Cindi (McColley) – NO SPURS, soft legs, if you bang on her she will get hot easily especially during patterns. Must be light on her sides. Spur Trained, Light to medium contact, knowns verbal commands. Good Draw. Legs release/ Spur Stop. Legs on to back

Jake - (McColley) Spurs recommended, keep a soft leg, leg release stop, light to medium contact, responds to voice commands, do not use in patterns with spins. Don't trap him in reverse. Good Draw.

Charlie (McColley) - Light contact, leg release stop. Can be looky to the right, responds well to voice commands. NO SPURS.

Lilly (KCPH) - (SATURDAY ONLY) Does have a spur spot and responds better with legs than hands. Light contact. Good Draw. Walk Trot Only. Ball Spurs allowed if not in a walk trot class.

Grace (KCPH) - (SATURDAY ONLY) May use spurs. Good Draw, squeeze legs to slow down. Spur Stop. Very light contact, as she likes her face. Good for leads, can job slow when asked.

Dusty (KCPH) (SATURDAY ONLY) Use spurs if allowed as he can get lazy. Light to no contact. Spur stop

Woody- (Hancock) App gelding. Good draw. Reiner type. Ride with light contact. NO SPURS. Use in higher levels Ruby and up good for patterns.

Kernal- (Hancock) Grulla QH. Ride quiet with seat legs and hands. Set up for leads. NO SPURS. Use in higher levels Ruby and up only rail.

Milo: (Hancock) Reiner, Use spurs allowed by your division. Will be good in walk/jog divisions without spurs. Overall consistent good draw.

Bree (Hancock) -Appaloosa Mare, Good Draw, Ball Spurs only. Good in Walk/jog classes without spurs. Set up for right lead. Very light rein contact. Don't bridle her up too tight!

Horse Descriptions Page 2 of 3

Chester- (Hancock) Chestnut Quarter Horse Gelding. Good draw. Stay relaxed on him. Can ride with light contact. Easy draw and great pattern horse. Squeeze to slow down and kiss to lope off. Talk to him when you stop and break down to trot or walk. Ball spurs preferred but can use rowel.

Remi- (Hancock) Sorrel Quarter Horse Mare. Good draw. Ride with light contact. Has a leg release stop. Set up for leads. Great pattern horse. To slow down release your legs off of her, but not so much she will stop. Do not squeeze to slow her down, it will make her go faster. Ball spurs only.

Diesel- (Hancock) good draw. Ride collected but not trapped. Division appropriate spurs, may need crop for walk trot check with horse provider. Set up for leads.

Annabelle- (Hancock) Haflinger Mare. Ride with two hands. Quiet smooth ride. NO SPURS.

Doc (Hancock) – Buckskin QH, Division Appropriate Spurs OK, Ranch Type, Ride with strong leg but don't over use spurs. Ride with light rein contact. Responds well to voice commands

Mister (Champion Hill) – Big Mover, go to bridle to slow, set up for leads has a flying lead. No Spurs

Hope (Champion Hill) – Consistent, Keep on the Rail always the same horse. Good with voice. Will start dropping her shoulder as day goes on. NO SPURS

Benny (Champion Hill) – Walk Trot Only. Lesson Horse. Ride in the bridle, responds well to voice commands. **Steward and paddock master or owner must be the one who changes the saddle or adjust the saddle (he bites at himself)!!!!!!!!** Weight restriction due to age. #175

Travis (Puthoff) Very Good Draw, No Spurs (may change to Ball Spurs later in the day, check with the steward.) Light legs, set up for leads. He knows lead changes. Once loping don't use much leg.

Dawg (Puthoff) Reiner & Horsemanship, Ball Spurs or Dull Spurs (Division Appropriate). LOTS of calf for lead changes. Can be used in Reining but don't chase for stops. Set up for Leads.

Zip (Puthoff) Quiet, Easy Draw. Ball Spurs or Dull Spurs (Division Appropriate). Lazy.

Chloe (Puthoff) Ball Spurs or Dull Spurs (Division Appropriate). Set up for leads, use leg!

EMMETT - (BayHill) sorrel gelding, can be lazy, spurs or crop.

DANNY - (BayHill) sorrel gelding, light contact. If you hold too tight he won't go forward. Set up for leads, spurs or a crop.

Bella: (Bayhill) Good Spins. Good lead changes. Will get restless in the middle so don't stand very long. she will get hot if you try to run her too hard.

GINGER - (BayHill) sorrel mare, great draw, light contact. Set up for leads, spurs or crop

Sly (BayHill) – Bay Gelding, set up for leads. Smooth lope and trot. Can go without spurs. Great Pattern Horse, Reiner Type.

Forrest: (Arnold) Light rein contact. Rowel or ball spur depending on division. Use hand and leg to support into lope transition and to collect on rail. Has spur stop for patterns.

Freddie: (Arnold) Good Draw! Loose rein easy ride ball spurs.

Gabby: (Arnold) Good Draw! Use light contact. Ball Spurs or No Spurs (Check with Steward)

Rocky: (Arnold) Light rein contact. No Spurs. May anticipate on patterns. Just don't rush him in transitions. No Spurs. Let horse holder put numbers in number holders HATES to have his flank area touched. Great to ride. Great Draw.

Sissy: (Arnold) Light rein contact. Support with hand and use leg to collect. Needs to be set up for right lead. Hand to rail and push hip in. Stay forward in turns for patterns. Ball Spurs Only

Melody - (EQD) Red Dun QH mare. Needs ridden with contact but not a lot of bit pressure. Support with leg for lope. Spurs needed for lope.

Sugar: (EQD) Buckskin QH Mare (EQD)- Use soft holding contact on her mouth. Can slow her bouncy trot by softening mouth. Set up for leads. Will go with or without spurs.

Nala (EQD) Solid Paint Maire, Really nice horse. She needs a little pushing at times so a crop is ok. She is spur broke. Needs set up for transitions. Will cut corners if the rider allows.

Dakota (EQD) Appaloosa gelding. Works really well off of seat and leg. Rider will need to maintain some soft contact on the bit and set up for transitions. Can get forward in transitions, bump on the bit will bring him back down. Can you spurs on him but he does well without.

Rawhide (Timmerman's) – (Wt Horse due to age #175) Older Horse, VERY QUIET! 16 hands tall. Great for walk/trot! No Spurs, No Crop!

Big Shot (Timmerman's) – 15' 3 hand gelding, steady eddie horse. Great Draw. Set up for right lead, turn head until he has picked up the lead. No Spurs, No Crop!

Squirt (Timmermans) Roping Horse, Older Horse, very quiet! Easy going, basic cues. Medium contact. 14'3" Height/Weight Horse 5'7" & 175# No Spurs, No Crop!

Handsome (Timmermans) Chestnut Morgan 14'3", Height Horse 5'7", Can have a higher head carriage, medium contact, can have a sticky right lead. Basic commands, no spur stop. No Spurs, No Crop!

Sassy - (M&M) basic Walk trot, medium Rein. Kick to go. Say easy and pull to walk 2 hands

jay (M&M) – Ranch Horse type, can go slow on the rail. Spurs Ok

Molly (M&M) Reiner - she has a lot of go. Spurs optional, probably not needed. Traditionally broke like a reiner, feet away to stop. Keep bridled with minimal contact. Lots of hand to leg connection. Very talented. Easy lead change. WIII not hesitate well in the middle for the reining. She is a cute Reiner at 13'3" so she is going to be a Height/Weight #175 and 5'7"

Shorty (Arthur) Height Weight Height/Weight #175 and 5'7" No spurs ride two-handed, ranch horse type ride with Light contact not a drape rain ride off the rail can get looky. Let her walk out at the walk, rider choose her speed for jog and lope, very sensitive, light leg and hands.

Manny (Arthur) Light contact on his face, protect his leads **<u>especially</u>** in patterns. Very light leg in patterns. Pull to slow down. Spur stop. Spurs in appropriate divisions rowels are fine. VERY GOOD DRAW

Gauge – (TGR) Sorrel Quarter Horse gelding, Rommel Reins, Rowel and ball spurs ok. Use inside led to keep on the rail, kiss to lope, pull back and apply even leg pressure to back, can be more forward at the lope and slow at the jog but all gaits are smooth, set up for both leads. **Mya** – (Grimm) Black Quarter Pony Mare, 14.1 Hands, light to moderate rein contact, sit deep and squeeze calf softly to slow, spur stop, hold spur or heel softly with equal pressure to back, use soft voice commands (kiss to lope, verbally say trot, and back and walk softly while cueing with legs.) If you are good with spurs rowels are ok, if not ball spurs or no spurs will work.

Jay (M&M) – Ranch Horse type, can go slow on the rail. Spurs Ok

Bess Keep her bridled and use legs, but no spur stop. She is a pony but ok with bigger kids. She is very stout. Height Horse 5'7"
