Electric Policy!

YEDA will adhere to a very strict policy for the rest of YEDA show season **“No one can plug anything into any facility outlet”**. If a team or individual needs to plug in a truck, trailer or camper a hookup fee will be charged, which must be paid ahead of time in the YEDA office, once paid a permit will be given as proof of purchase. Hook up fees vary depending on location and charged per night. Generators are prohibited in and near the arena. You are welcome to bring a camper or horse trailer and park it in the camping area to house your generator and the items you plan to run off your generator. There will be a \$100 fine for generators outside designated areas or for plugging items in not in the camping area.

Many teams enjoy planning and bringing their team food to the shows and you can still do this but with a camper or trailer hook up fee and keep all your feasts appliances, crock pots, and food inside. We hope you will understand that we are not trying to be difficult but we must be respectful of the facilities that we are using and continue to show there for many years. 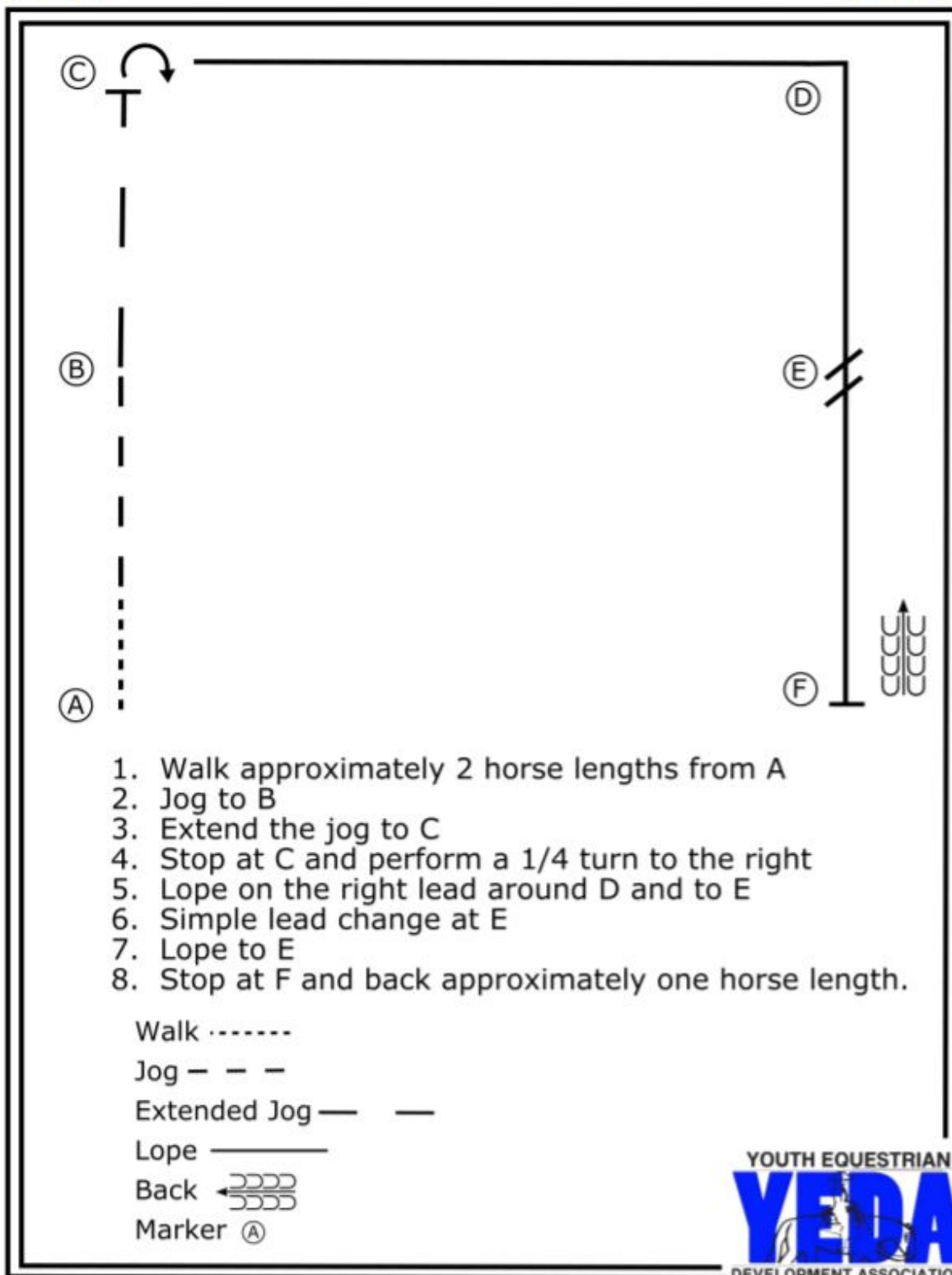
Emerald Pattern 12



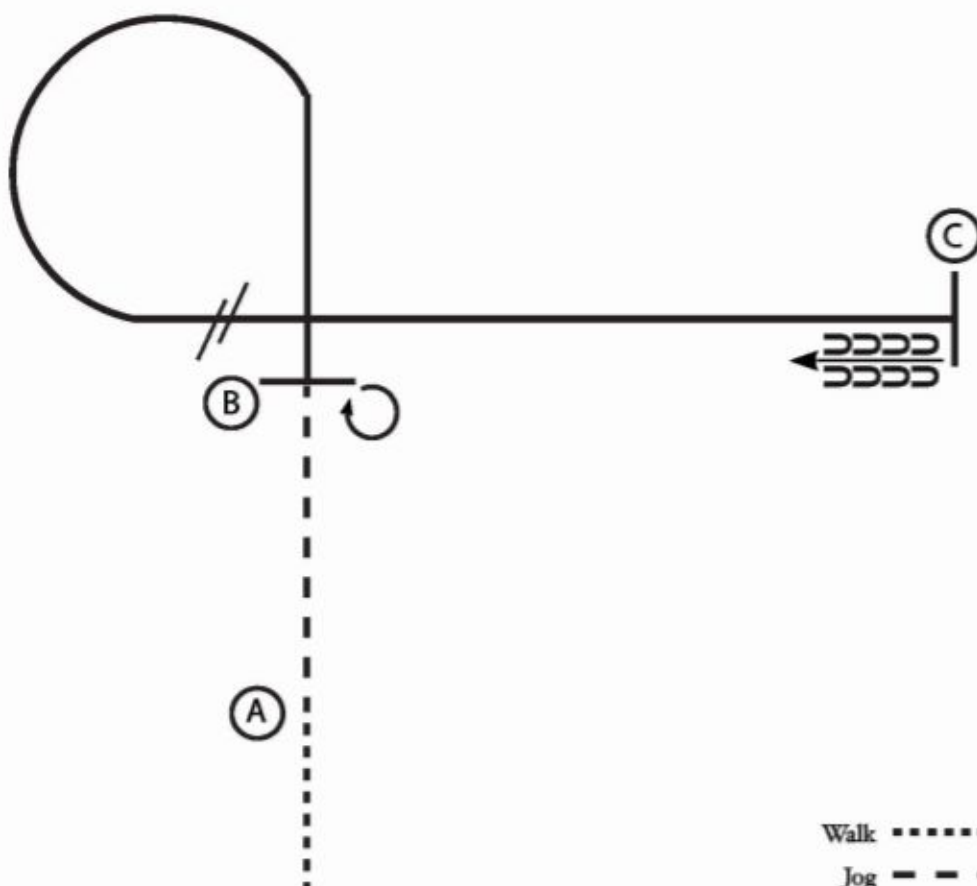

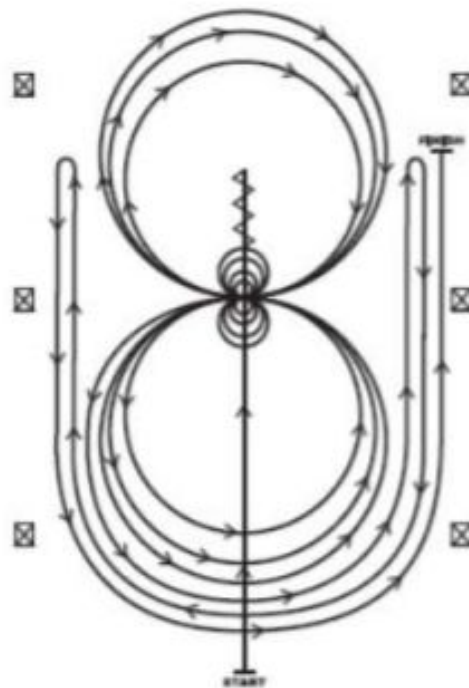

NRHA Pattern 12

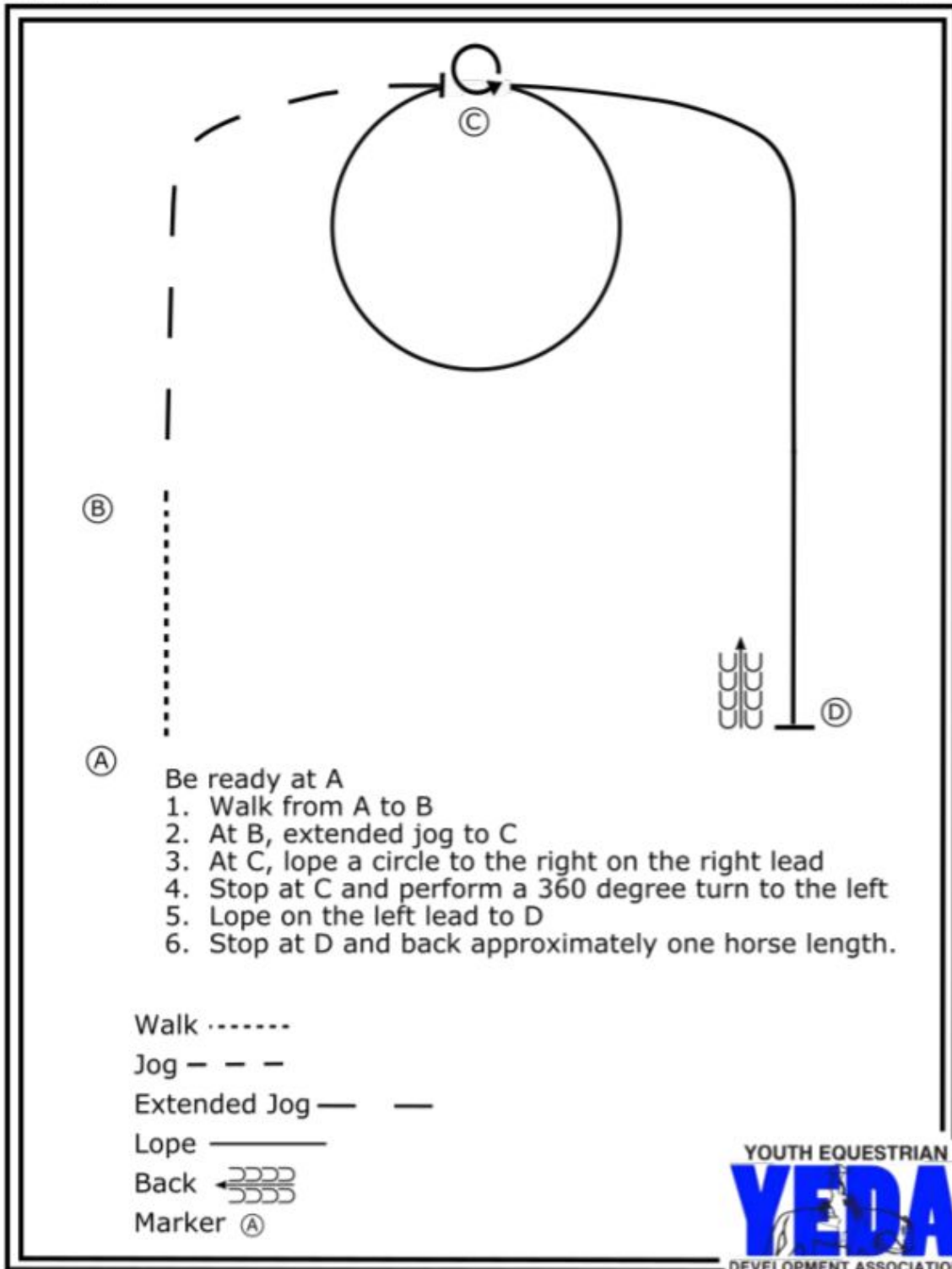


1. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to the center of the arena or at least 10 feet (3 meters). Hesitate.
2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Complete four and one-quarter spins to the left so that the horse is facing the left wall or fence. Hesitate.
4. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
5. Complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
6. Begin a large circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
7. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena and past the center marker and do a left rollback at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
8. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least 20 feet (6 meters) from the wall or fence. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of pattern.

Horse Descriptions

Sarah- (EQD) Sorrel Paint Mare. Spurs optional. Ride with light contact. Will drift to inside if allowed.

Junior-(EQD)- Bay QH Gelding. Ranch type horse, has some reining training. Responds quickly off of cues. Will go slow if asked but need to keep in the bridle. Set up for right lead. Spurs ok.

Stan- (EQD) Sorrel POA Gelding Ht/Wt Horse - Can get quick, hold with quiet rein. Set up for leads. May need spurs later day

Woody- (Hancock) App gelding. Good draw. Reiner type. Ride with light contact. NO SPURS. Use in higher levels Ruby and up good for patterns.

Kernal- (Hancock) Grulla QH. Ride quiet with seat legs and hands. Set up for leads. NO SPURS. Use in higher levels Ruby and up only rail.

Milo: (Hancock) Reiner, Use spurs allowed by your division. Will be good in walk/jog divisions without spurs. Overall consistent good draw.

Gator (Hancock) Palomino QH, Good Draw, Reiner Trained. Ball spurs for division appropriate classes

Bree (Hancock) -Appaloosa Mare, Good Draw, Ball Spurs only. Good in Walk/jog classes without spurs. Set up for right lead. Very light rein contact. Don't bridle her up too tight!

Izzy (Hancock) – Light rein contact. She gets cranky if you use too much hand or leg. Very broke. Reiner type. NO SPURS

Chester- (Hancock) Chestnut Quarter Horse Gelding. Good draw. Stay relaxed on him. Can ride with light contact. Easy draw and great pattern horse. Squeeze to slow down and kiss to lope off. Talk to him when you stop and break down to trot or walk. Ball spurs preferred but can use rowel.

Remi- (Hancock) Sorrel Quarter Horse Mare. Good draw. Ride with light contact. Has a leg release stop. Set up for leads. Great pattern horse. To slow down release your legs off of her, but not so much she will stop. Do not squeeze to slow her down, it will make her go faster. No spurs.

Scotch (KCPH) - Light contact in the bridle. Use legs. Has a spur stop. Drive into bridle for best ride. Ball spurs only if allowed .

Raider (KCPH) - Walk jog only. Power steering, great with hands and legs. Light contact. Super quiet, Good draw. Does have a spur stop so squeeze to stop.

Sheza (KCPH) Works off leg pressure. Rides best with soft hands.

Tuffy - (McColley) Spurs needed, set up for right lead, leg release to stop, light contact, will jog and lope slow but you have to make him and it requires a lot of leg, responds to voice command. Possible Two-Handed Option (check with show steward). Requires leg contact at the lope. Can have contact if leg is there to back it up. Good Draw.

Cindi (McColley) – NO SPURS, soft legs, if you bang on her she will get hot easily especially during patterns. Must be light on her sides. Spur Trained, Light to medium contact, knows verbal commands. Good Draw.

Jake - (McColley) Spurs recommended, keep a soft leg, leg release stop, light to medium contact, responds to voice commands, do not use in patterns with spins. Don't trap him in reverse. Good Draw.

Bud (McColley) - Spur stop. Light contact. Has lead change so watch legs during lope. No Spurs. Good Draw.

Cooper (McColley) - Easy going can go with or without spurs. use division appropriate spurs, possible two hand option, check with the steward and the board. Leg release stop, responds well to voice commands, set up for his leads, lighter contact, won't tolerate a super tight rein well. Will go slow for his size.

Tucker (M&M) – Walk trot only. Crop optional but shouldn't need it until the end of the day. Very basic and easy.

Molly (M & M) - Reiner Two handed option for reining. No spurs for the rail classes.

True (M & M) Reiner. Ask for soft stops. Spurs optional. Light rein contact. Big lead change. Has a hop to her right turn.

Jett (Royal Creek) - Sorrel mare QH – retired show horse. great draw, kiss and push opposite leg to lope, cluck to trot. Works off of leg pressure to pivot. Can use any spurs or no spurs - very easy to ride

Rosie (Royal Creek) - Sorrel mare QH- retired show horse. great draw, kiss and push opposite leg to lope, cluck to trot. Works off of leg pressure to pivot. Can use any spurs or no spurs

Miles (Royal Creek) - Bay gelding. Spurs required. Beautiful lead change, not completely finished on fast spins. Will do upper level rail classes.

Rawhide (Timmermanns)- Weight horse. Older horse. VERY QUIET. Great for walk/trot. No spurs, no crop.

Big Shot (Timmermanns) Steady Eddie horse. Great draw. Set up for right lead, turn head until he has to pick up the lead.

Squirt (Timmermanns) Roping Horse, Older Horse, very quiet! Easy going, basic cues. Medium contact. 14'3" Height/Weight Horse 5'7" & 175# No Spurs, No Crop!

Handsome (Timmermanns) Chestnut Morgan 14'3", Height Horse 5'7", Can have a higher head carriage, medium contact, can have a sticky right lead. Basic commands, no spur stop. No Spurs, No Crop!

Reggie (Albion) One handed. Has a spur stop. Squeeze to collect and slow down. Bump with legs to drive forward. Bump legs and "hiss" to extend the trop. Outside leg and light rein contact to lope. Good draw!

Kat (Albion) Rides like a reiner. Set up for leads. She lays on the right shoulder in the right lead. Inside leg at the girth to hold shoulder up and outside leg behind the girth for lead departure. Hum to slow down. Release legs and sit to stop.

Jade (Albion) One handed. Loose rein contact. Has a spur stop. Hum to slow down while maintaining light leg contact. Picks up leads well. Gets nervous with too much rein contact.

NRHA Pattern 4



Horses may walk or jog to the center of the arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
2. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
4. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
5. Beginning on the right lead, run a large fast circle to the right, change leads at the center of the arena, run large fast circle to the left, and change leads at the center of the arena. (Figure 8)
6. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
7. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
8. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions

Sarah (EQD) Sorrel Paint Mare. Spurs optional. Ride with light contact. Will drift to inside if allowed.

Junior (EQD)- Bay QH Gelding. Ranch type horse, has some reining training. Responds quickly off of cues. Will go slow if asked but need to keep in the bridle. Set up for right lead. Spurs ok.

Stan (EQD) Sorrel POA Gelding Ht/Wt Horse - Can get quick, hold with quiet rein. Set up for leads. May need spurs later day

Woody (Hancock) App gelding. Good draw. Reiner type. Ride with light contact. NO SPURS. Use in higher levels Ruby and up good for patterns.

Kernal (Hancock) Grulla QH. Ride quiet with seat legs and hands. Set up for leads. NO SPURS. Use in higher levels Ruby and up only rail.

Milo: (Hancock) Reiner, Use spurs allowed by your division. Will be good in walk/jog divisions without spurs. Overall consistent good draw.

Gator (Hancock) Palomino QH, Good Draw, Reiner Trained.

Bree (Hancock) -Appaloosa Mare, Good Draw, Ball Spurs only. Good in Walk/jog classes without spurs. Set up for right lead. Very light rein contact. Don't bridle her up too tight!

Izzy (Hancock) – Light rein contact. She gets cranky if you use too much hand or leg. Very broke. Reiner type. NO SPURS

Chester (Hancock) Chestnut Quarter Horse Gelding. Good draw. Stay relaxed on him. Can ride with light contact. Easy draw and great pattern horse. Squeeze to slow down and kiss to lope off. Talk to him when you stop and break down to trot or walk. Ball spurs preferred but can use rowel.

Remi (Hancock) Sorrel Quarter Horse Mare. Good draw. Ride with light contact. Has a leg release stop. Set up for leads. Great pattern horse. To slow down release your legs off of her, but not so much she will stop. Do not squeeze to slow her down, it will make her go faster. Ball spurs only.

Scotch (KCPH) - Light contact in the bridle. Use legs. Has a spur stop. Drive into bridle for best ride. Ball spurs only if allowed .

Raider (KCPH) - Walk jog only. Power steering, great with hands and legs. Light contact. Super quiet, Good draw. Does have a spur stop so squeeze to stop.

Sheza (KCPH) Works off leg pressure. Rides best with soft hands.

Tuffy (McColley) Spurs needed, set up for right lead, leg release to stop, light contact, will jog and lope slow but you have to make him and it requires a lot of leg, responds to voice command. Possible Two-Handed Option (check with show steward). Requires leg contact at the lope. Can have contact if leg is there to back it up. Good Draw.

Cindi (McColley) – NO SPURS, soft legs, if you bang on her she will get hot easily especially during patterns. Must be light on her sides. Spur Trained, Light to medium contact, knows verbal commands. Good Draw.

Jake (McColley) Spurs recommended, keep a soft leg, leg release stop, light to medium contact, responds to voice commands, do not use in patterns with spins. Don't trap him in reverse. Good Draw.

Bud (McColley) - Spur stop. Light contact. Has lead change so watch legs during lope. No Spurs. Good Draw.

Cooper (McColley) - Easy going can go with or without spurs, use division appropriate spurs, possible two hand option, check with steward and the board. Leg release stop, responds well to voice commands, set up for his leads, lighter contact, won't tolerate a super tight rein well. Will go slow for his size.

Tucker (M&M) – Walk trot only. Crop optional but shouldn't need it until the end of the day. Very basic and easy.

Molly (M & M) Reiner. Two handed option for reining. No spurs for the rail classes.

Tucker (M&M) – Walk trot only. Crop optional but shouldn't need it until the end of the day. Very basic and easy

Jett (Royal Creek) - Sorrel mare QH – retired show horse. great draw, kiss and push opposite leg to lope, cluck to trot. Works off of leg pressure to pivot. Can use any spurs or no spurs - very easy to ride

Rosie (Royal Creek) - Sorrel mare QH- retired show horse. great draw, kiss and push opposite leg to lope, cluck to trot. Works off of leg pressure to pivot. Can use any spurs or no spurs

Miles (Royal Creek) Reiner. Bay gelding. Spurs required. Beautiful lead change, not completely finished on fast spins. Will do upper level rail classes.

Rawhide (Timmermanns)- Weight horse. Older horse. VERY QUIET. Great for walk/trot. No spurs, no crop.

Big Shot (Timmermanns) Steady Eddie horse. Great draw. Set up for right lead, turn head until he has to pick up the lead.

Squirt (Timmermanns) Roping Horse, Older Horse, very quiet! Easy going, basic cues. Medium contact. 14'3" Height/Weight Horse 5'7" & 175# No Spurs, No Crop!

Handsome (Timmermanns) Chestnut Morgan 14'3", Height Horse 5'7", Can have a higher head carriage, medium contact, can have a sticky right lead. Basic commands, no spur stop. No Spurs, No Crop!

Reggie (Albion) One handed. Has a spur stop. Squeeze to collect and slow down. Bump with legs to drive forward. Bump legs and "hiss" to extend the trop. Outside leg and light rein contact to lope. Good draw!

Kat (Albion) Rides like a reiner. Set up for leads. She lays on the right shoulder in the right lead. Inside leg at the girth to hold shoulder up and outside leg behind the girth for lead departure. Hum to slow down. Release legs and sit to stop.

Jade (Albion) One handed. Loose rein contact. Has a spur stop. Hum to slow down while maintaining light leg contact. Picks up leads well. Gets nervous with too much rein contact.
