Bailey: Buckskin Paint Gelding: (EQD)- Can get grouchy if over bridled. Steady quiet hands and seat. Spurs ok, but don't overuse.

Blue: Sorrel/White Paint Mare (EQD)- Easy ride. Keep in the bridle and will give a good ride. Firm leg. Spurs ok.

Darlene : Black/White Paint Mare (EQD)- Set up for right lead. Soft hand. Spur stops, collect with leg. Spurs ok.

ForSale : Sorrel Paint Gelding (EQD)- Spur trained. Give and take with his face. Set up for leads.

Grinder: (MH) Does all maneuvers well, needs to be pushed into bridle and supported to stops. Otherwise, he will front end his stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.

Junior: Bay QH Gelding (EQD)- Keep collected and will give a good ride. Firm leg. Spurs ok.

Hope: (CH) Will drop inside shoulder, no spurs. Use voice. Don't over cinch.

Marshall: Appy Gelding (EQD)- Set up & hold into lope transitions. Lots of leg. Set up for right lead. Spurs and crop ok.

Melody:(EQD) Red Dun QH mare. Needs ridden with contact but not a lot of bit pressure. Support with leg for lope. Spurs needed for lope.

Moon: Bay QH Gelding (EQD)- Can get lazy. May carry crop, but use kindly. Set up for leads. Spurs ok.

Mystic: White/Sorrel Paint Mare (EQD)- Can get strong. Set up for leads. Sensitive to leg cues. No spurs.

Rusty: Draft X (EQD)- Set up for right lead. Keep mouth contact. Lots of legs for lope and steering. Spurs & crop ok.

Stanlee-(EQD) with or without spurs, hold with leg and rein to slow down, smooth ride, ignore "cranky" ears.

Stan: Sorrel POA Gelding (EQD)- Can get quick, hold with quiet rein. Set up for leads. May need spurs later day.

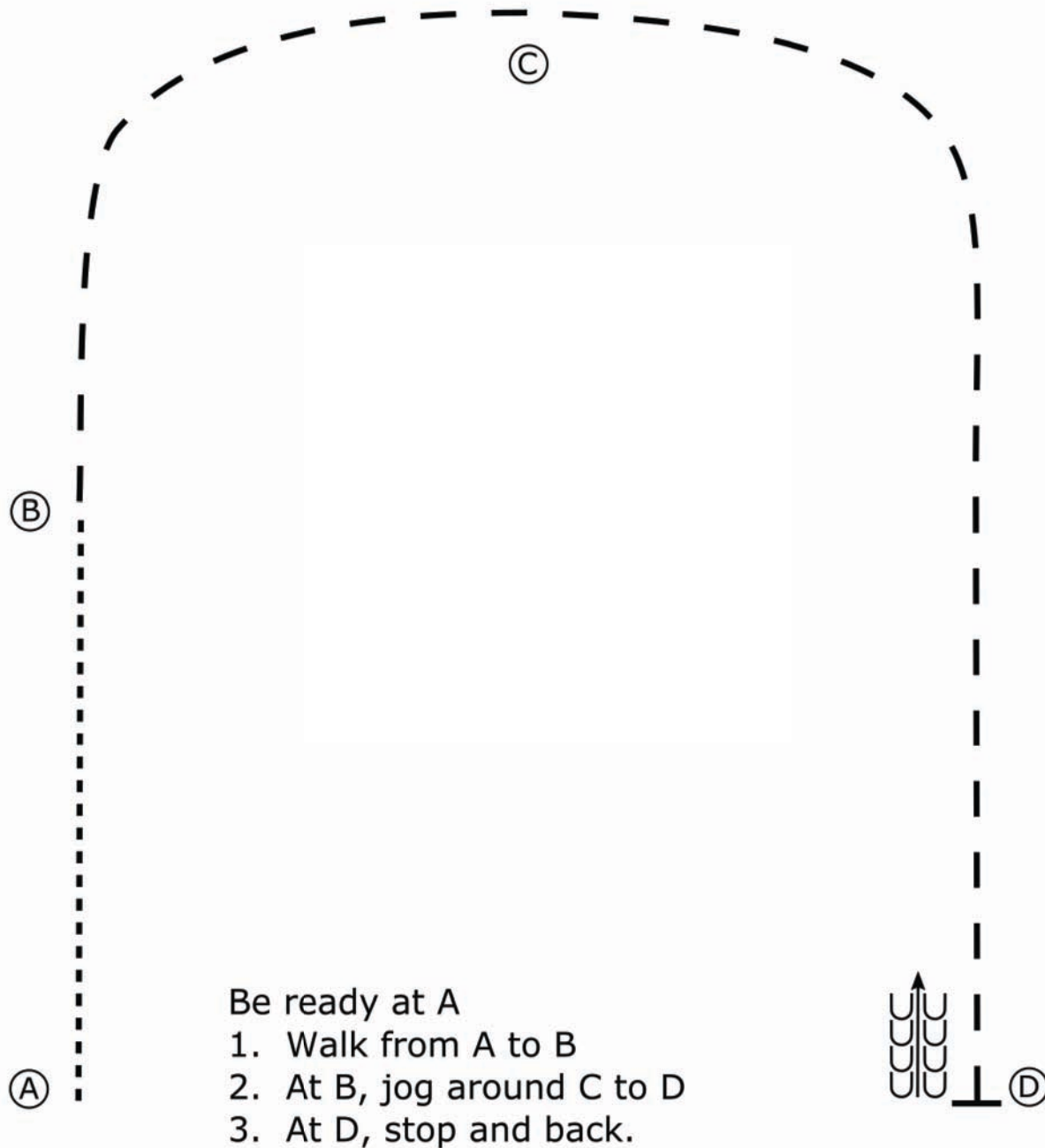
Sunny: Sorrel Paint Mare (EQD)- Stay quiet but firm with leg and mouth contact. Can get large if allowed. Will settle in with quiet seat and consistent contact. Spurs ok.


Sugar: Buckskin QH Mare (EQD)- Use soft holding contact on her mouth. Can slow her bouncy trot by softening mouth. Set up for leads. Will go with or without spurs.

Tommy: Appaloosa Gelding (EQD)- Can be stubborn. Can use division appropriate spurs.

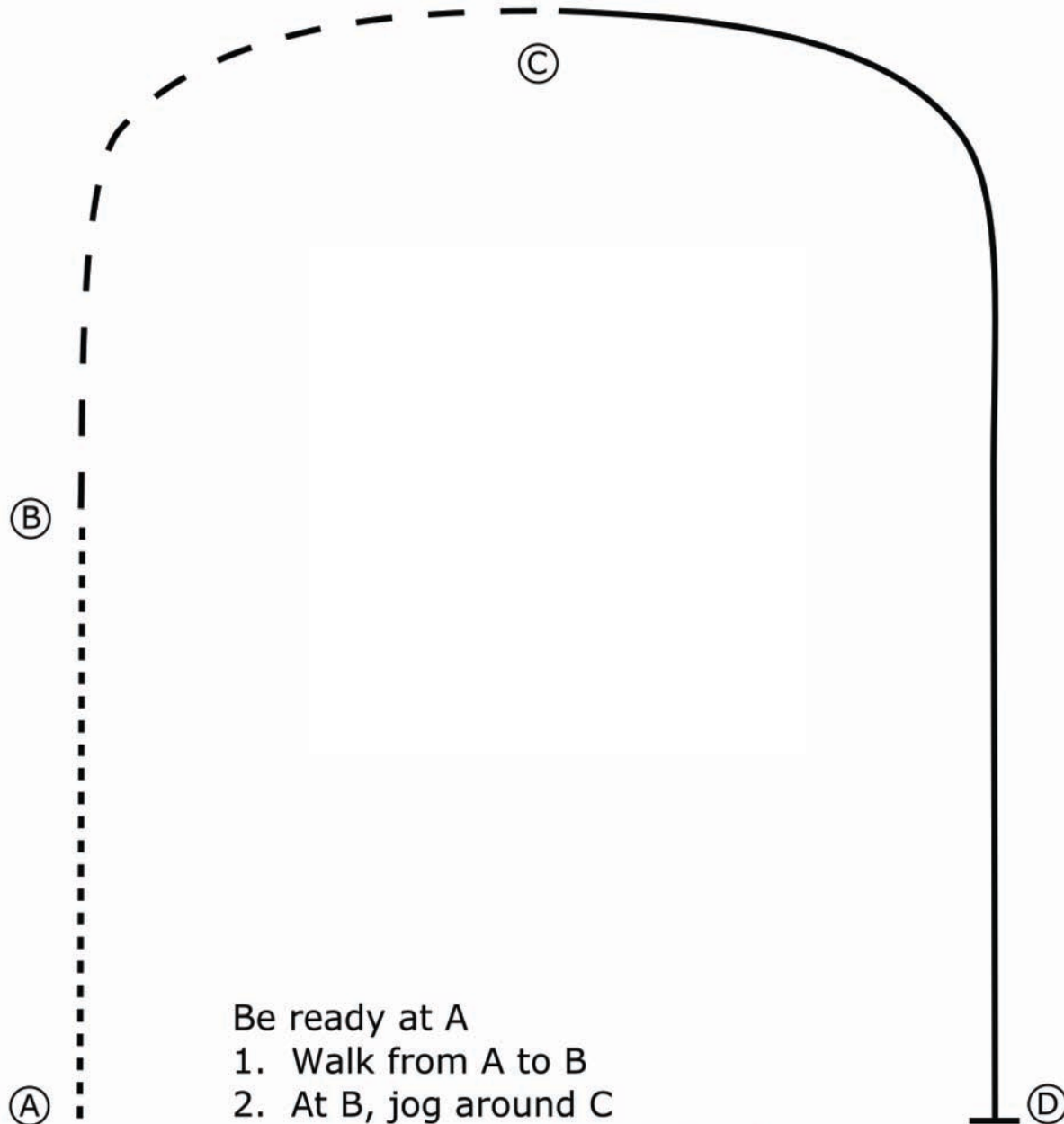
Val: Arab Mare (CH)- Voice commands, light leg or she will really extend her trot. Can get bouncy.

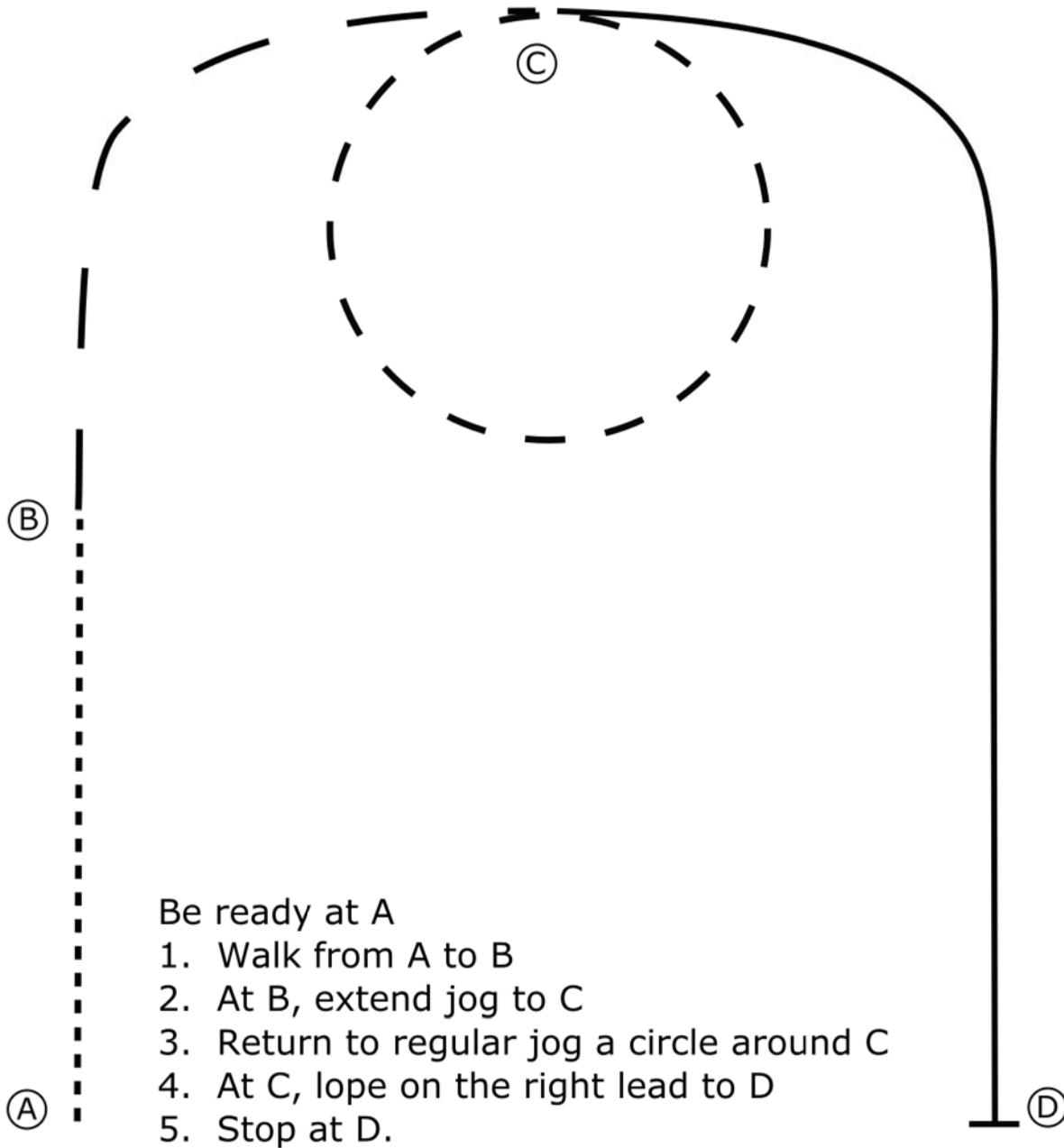

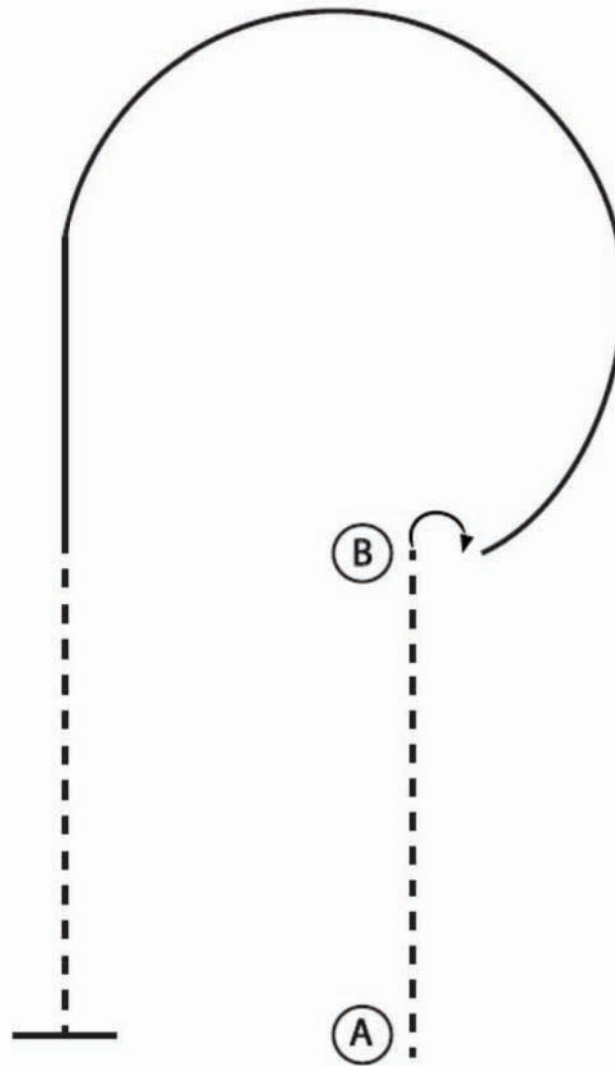

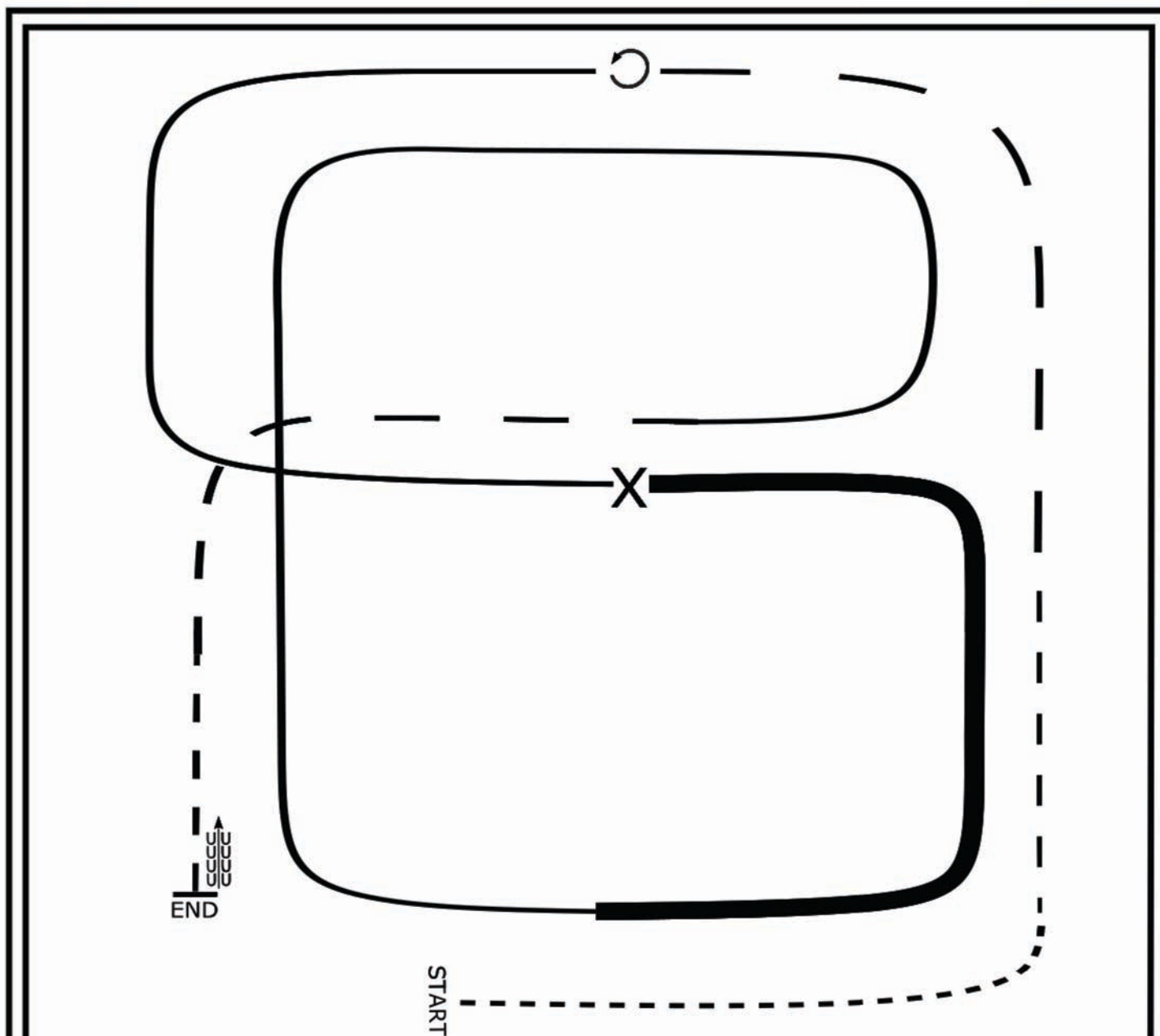
