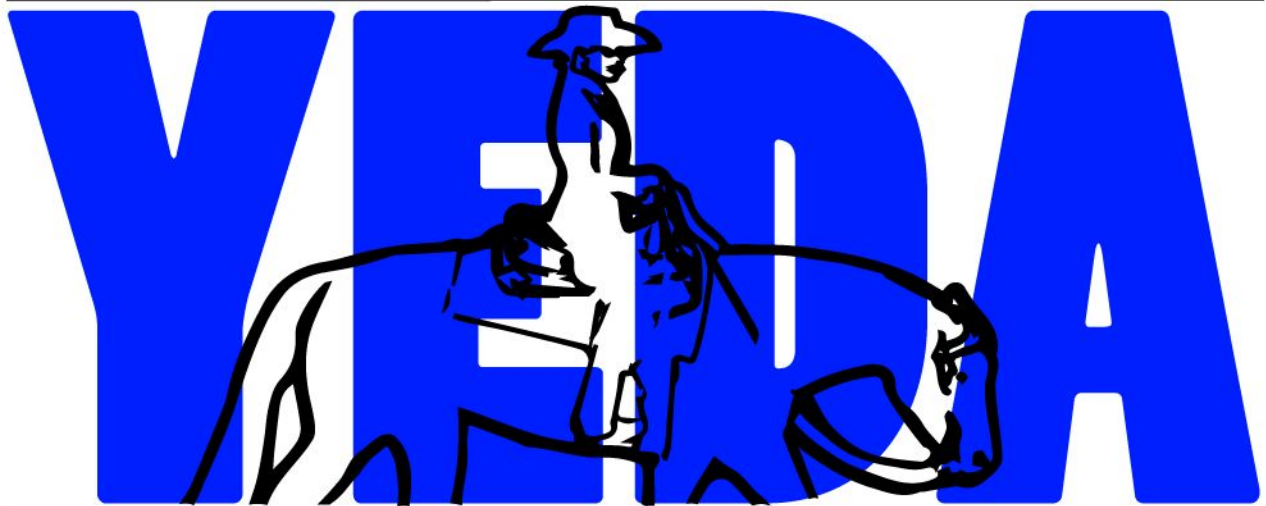

Electric Policy!

YEDA will adhere to a very strict policy for the rest of YEDA show season **“No one can plug anything into any facility outlet”**. If a team or individual needs to plug in a truck, trailer or camper a hookup fee will be charged, which must be paid ahead of time in the YEDA office, once paid a permit will be given as proof of purchase. Hook up fees vary depending on location and charged per night. Generators are prohibited in and near the arena. You are welcome to bring a camper or horse trailer and park it in the camping area to house your generator and the items you plan to run off your generator. There will be a \$100 fine for generators outside designated areas or for plugging items in not in the camping area.

Many teams enjoy planning and bringing their team food to the shows and you can still do this but with a camper or trailer hook up fee and keep all your feasts appliances, crock pots, and food inside. We hope you will understand that we are not trying to be difficult but we must be respectful of the facilities that we are using and continue to show there for many years. 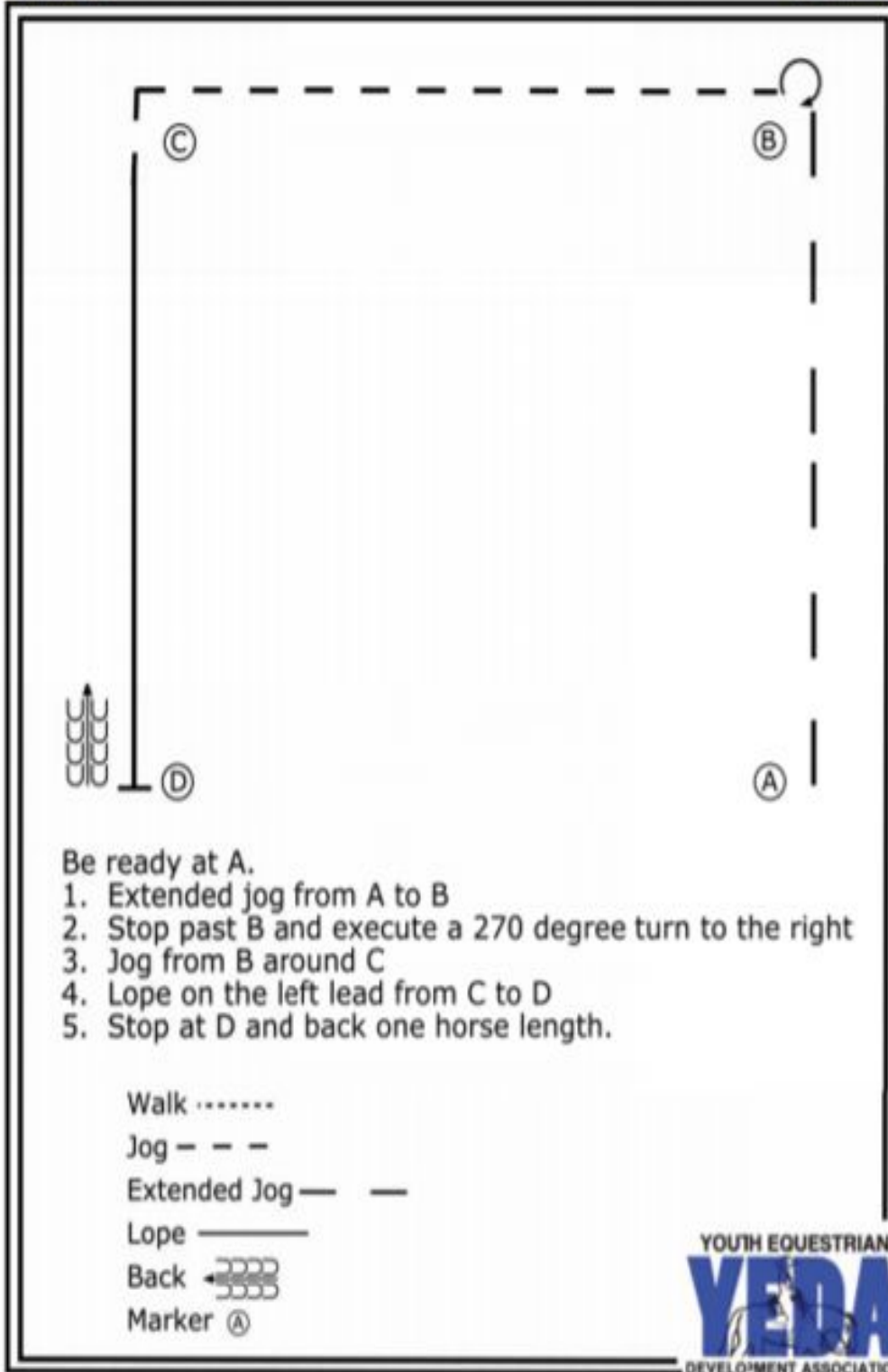
Emerald Pattern 3



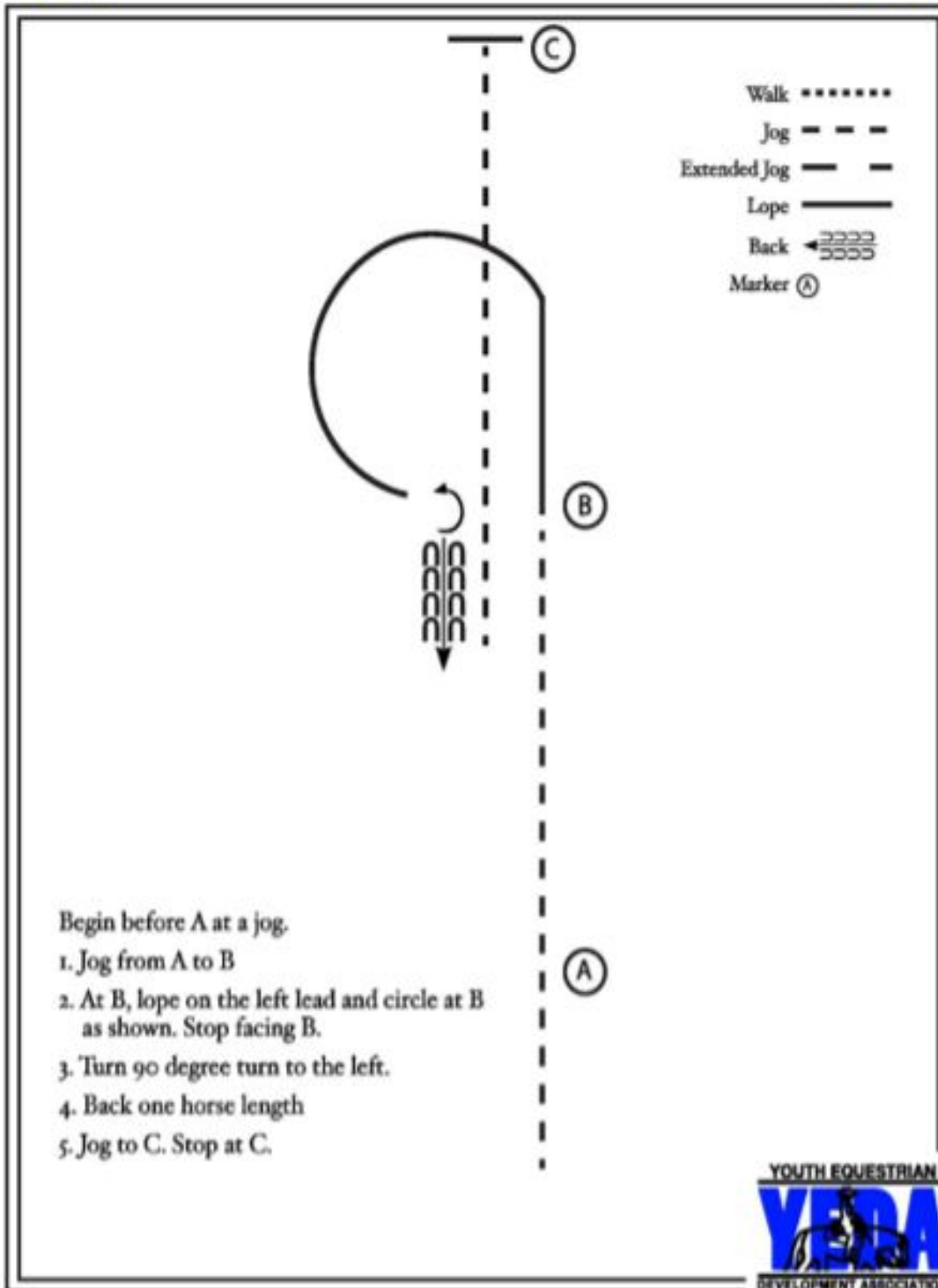

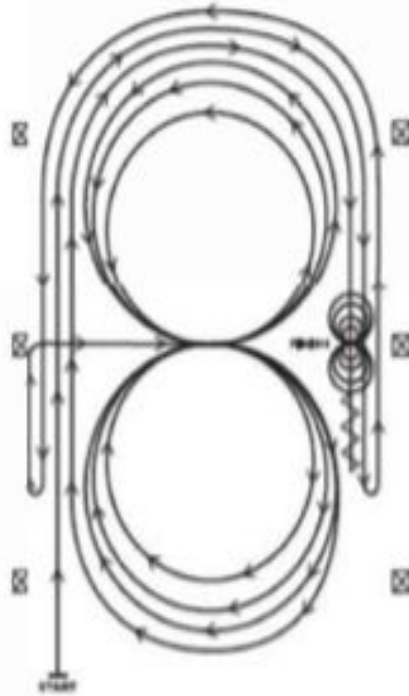

NRHA Pattern 3



1. Beginning, lope straight up the left side of the arena, circle the top end of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from the walls or fence, run straight down the opposite or right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.

2. Continue straight up the right side of the arena circle back around the top of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from the walls or fence, run straight down the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.

3. Continue up the left side of the arena to the center marker. At the center marker, the horse should be on the right lead. Guide the horse to the center of the arena on the right lead and complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.

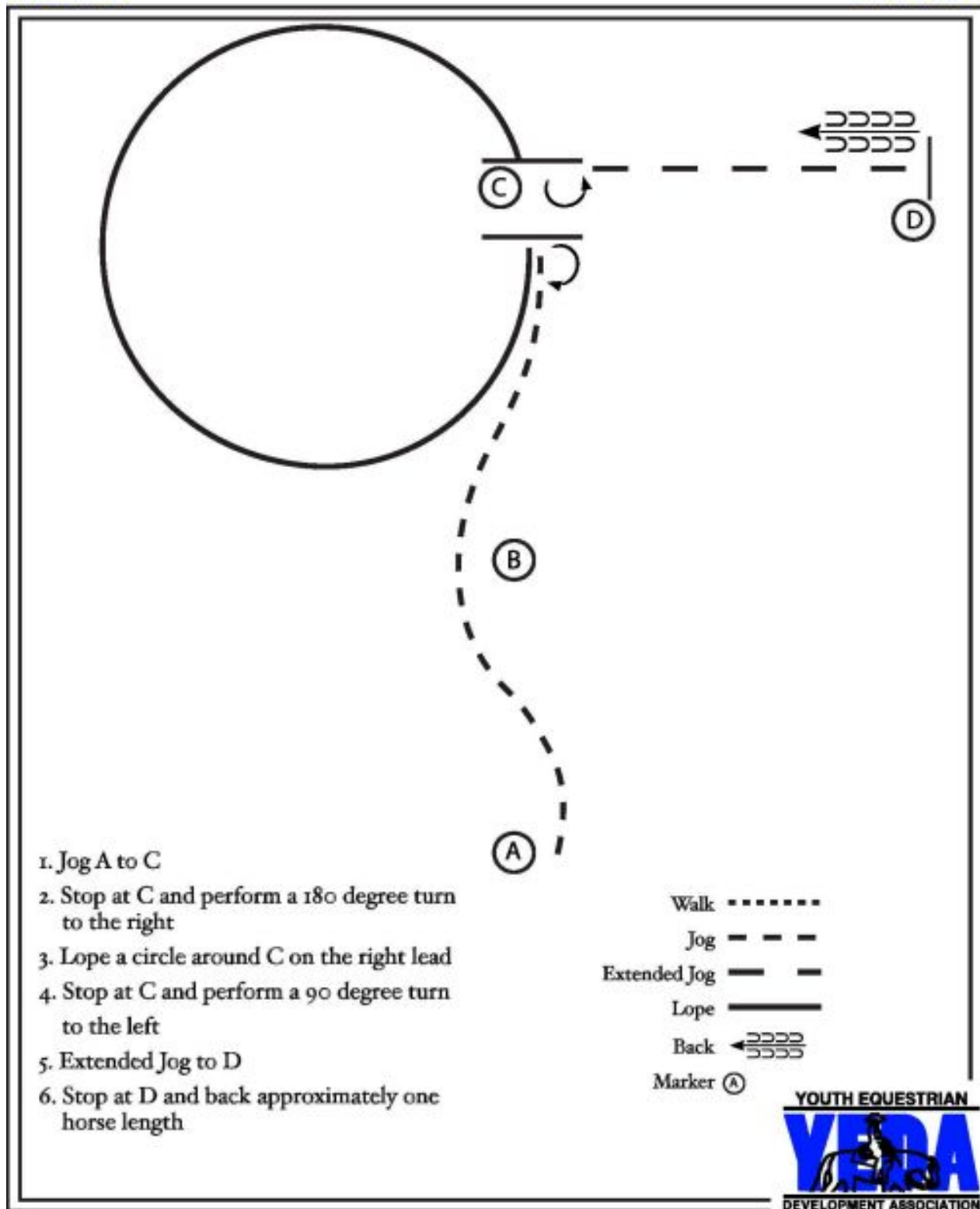
4. Complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads in the center of the arena.

5. Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Continue up the left side of the arena, circle the top of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from the walls or fence, run straight down the opposite or right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.

6. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

Diamond Pattern 10



Horse Descriptions

Forrest- (Arnold) Sorrel Paint Gelding Light Rein contact. Rowel or Ball Spurs depending on division. Use hand and leg to support into lope transition and to collect on rail. Has spur stop for patterns

Freddie-(Arnold) Bay QH gelding. Light contact. No Spurs.

Scooter- (Double H) Buckskin gelding. Set up for right lead. Ball spurs ok.

Skinny- (Double H) Black mare. Bouncy, stay soft. Ball spurs ok.

Stetson- (Double H) **Need description from Lynlee**

Kernal- (Hancock) Grulla QH. Good draw. Ride with light contact, do not trap his face. Set up for leads. **NO SPURS.**

Milo: (Hancock) Reiner, Hold during run downs in reining. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Leg release stop. Honest; great draw.

Gator (Hancock) Palomino QH, Reiner type. Leg release stop. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Light contact with bit. Honest, great draw.

Mia (Hancock) - Ranch type. Will move forward. NO SPURS. Will soften in bridle but will not set head. Set up for leads. Keep leg contact while loping. Good draw.

Eric (Hancock) – Reiner type. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Lazy use leg contact to keep true gaits. Will over bridle easy, so really light hands and light rein contact. Honest good draw.

Cash (Hickory Ridge) - Works off seat and legs. Sit in saddle, or he will want to move out. Can be lazy. Make sure you get a true gait. Ball spurs ok.

Chip (Hickory Ridge) - Pleasure type gelding, Neck reins. Encourage with legs to get going. Does best on a loose rein. Nice slow trot when collected up. Walk trot..

Jet (Southern Ohio) Black QH gelding. Must use spurs and lots of leg. Light hands, can be lazy.

Smartie - (Southern Ohio) Sorrel QH gelding. Use very light cues, voice commands. Maintain contact and set up for leads. No spurs.

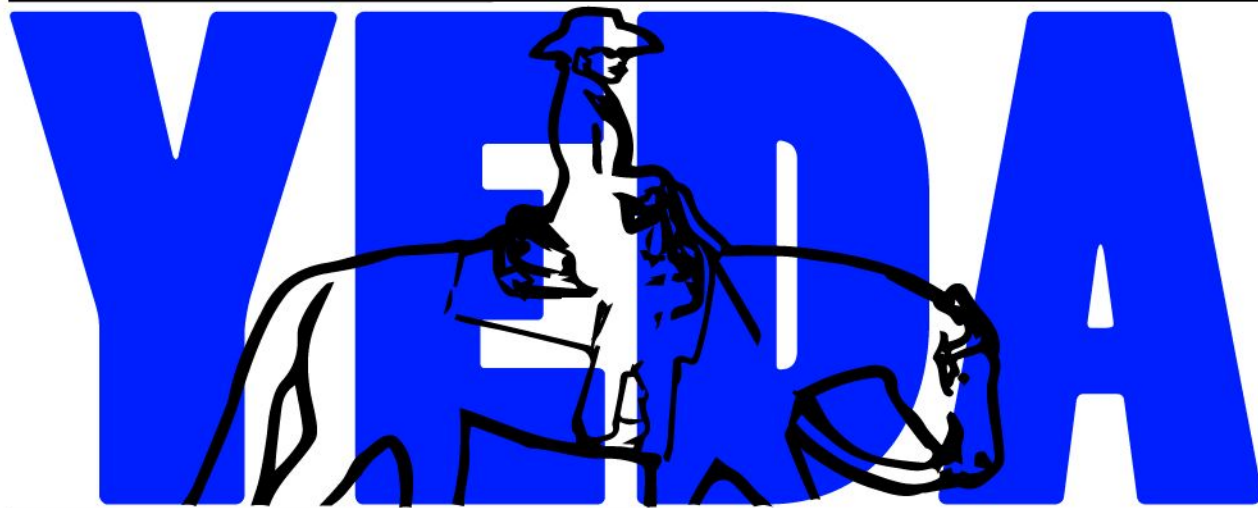
Ali (Southern Ohio) Bay QH mare. Maintain light contact, use voice commands and cluck for the jog, kiss for the lope. Spurs ok according to division.

Blue: (Marsha) Sorrel/White Paint Mare Easy ride. Keep in the bridle and will give a good ride. Quiet Firm leg. Spurs ok.

Jess-(Marsha) Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs

Grinder- (Marsha) Does all maneuvers well. Needs to be pushed into the bridle and supported to stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.

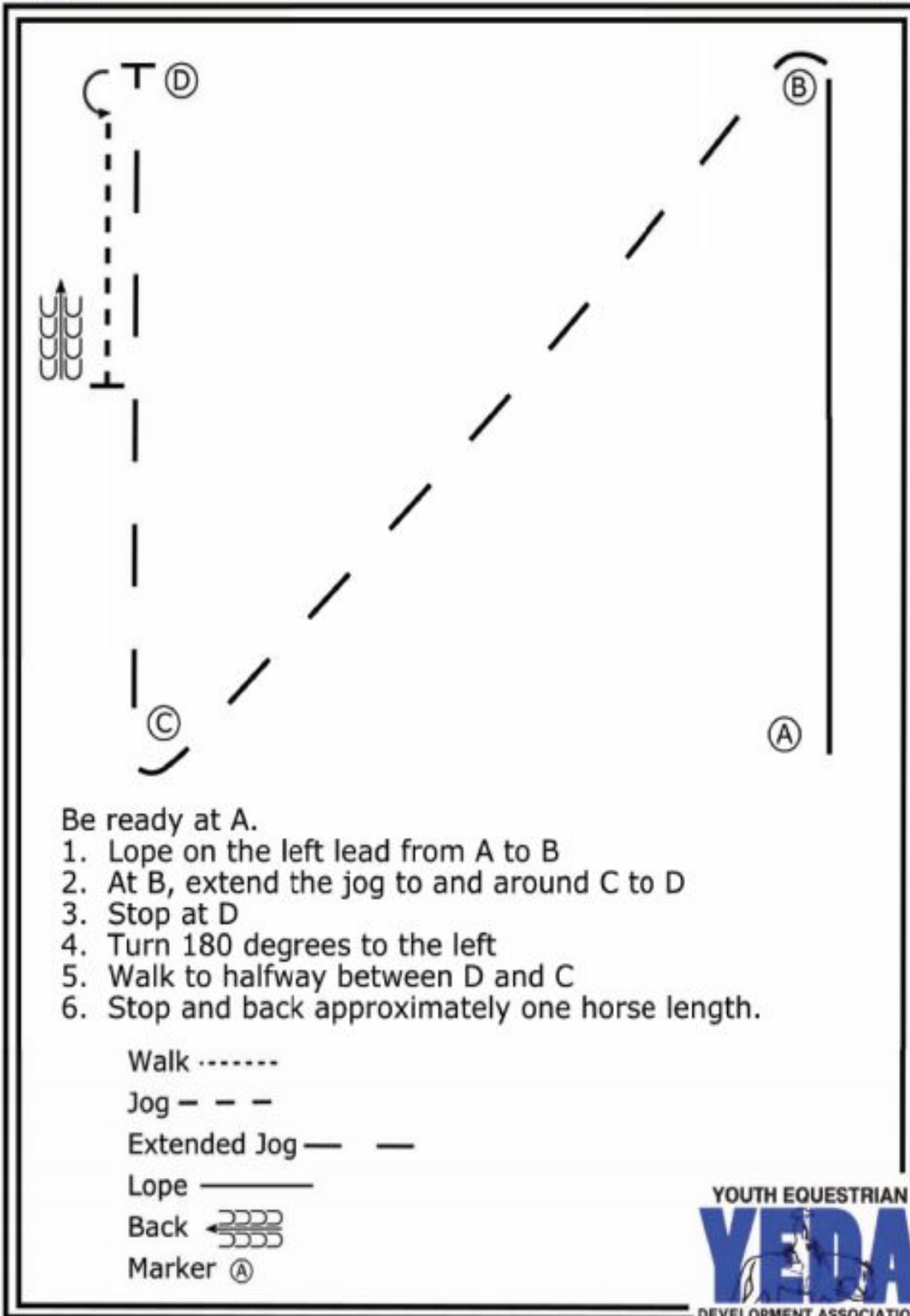
NRHA Pattern 2



Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
2. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
3. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
4. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
5. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (threemeters). Hesitate.
6. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions

Forrest- (Arnold) Sorrel Paint Gelding Light Rein contact. Rowel or Ball Spurs depending on division. Use hand and leg to support into lope transition and to collect on rail. Has spur stop for patterns

Freddie-(Arnold) Bay QH gelding. Light contact. No Spurs.

Scooter- (Double H) Buckskin gelding. Set up for right lead. Ball spurs ok.

Skinny- (Double H) Black mare. Bouncy, stay soft. Ball spurs ok.

Stetson- (Double H) **Need description from Lynlee**

Kernal- (Hancock) Grulla QH. Good draw. Ride with light contact, do not trap his face. Set up for leads. **NO SPURS.**

Milo: (Hancock) Reiner, Hold during run downs in reining. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Leg release stop. Honest; great draw.

Gator (Hancock) Palomino QH, Reiner type. Leg release stop. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Light contact with bit. Honest, great draw.

Mia (Hancock) - Ranch type. Will move forward. NO SPURS. Will soften in bridle but will not set head. Set up for leads. Keep leg contact while loping. Good draw.

Eric (Hancock) – Reiner type. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Lazy use leg contact to keep true gaits. Will over bridle easy, so really light hands and light rein contact. Honest good draw.

Cash (Hickory Ridge) - Works off seat and legs. Sit in saddle, or he will want to move out. Can be lazy. Make sure you get a true gait. Ball spurs ok.

Chip (Hickory Ridge) - Pleasure type gelding, Neck reins. Encourage with legs to get going. Does best on a loose rein. Nice slow trot when collected up. Walk trot..

Jet (Southern Ohio) Black QH gelding. Must use spurs and lots of leg. Light hands, can be lazy.

Smartie - (Southern Ohio) Sorrel QH gelding. Use very light cues, voice commands. Maintain contact and set up for leads. No spurs.

Ali (Southern Ohio) Bay QH mare. Maintain light contact, use voice commands and cluck for the jog, kiss for the lope. Spurs ok according to division.

Blue: (Marsha) Sorrel/White Paint Mare Easy ride. Keep in the bridle and will give a good ride. Quiet Firm leg. Spurs ok.

Jess-(Marsha) Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs

Grinder- (Marsha) Does all maneuvers well. Needs to be pushed into the bridle and supported to stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.
