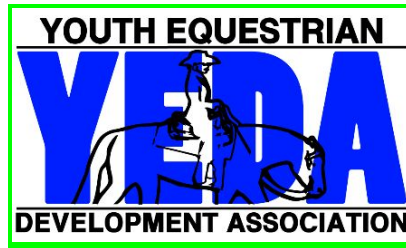

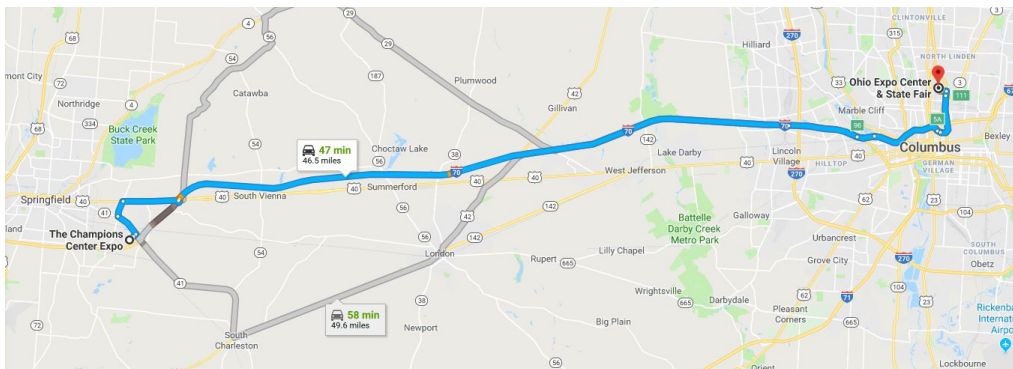

Electric Policy & Camping

YEDA will adhere to a very strict policy for all YEDA show; **“No one can plug anything into any facility outlet”**. If a team or individual needs to plug in a truck, trailer or camper a hookup fee will be charged, which must be paid ahead of time in the YEDA office, once paid a permit will be given as proof of purchase. **Hook up fees are \$30 per night, this is for each outlet (trucks and campers)**. Generators are prohibited in and near the arena. You are welcome to bring a camper or horse trailer and park it in the camping area to house your generator and the items you plan to run off your generator. There will be a \$100 fine for generators outside designated areas or for plugging items in not in the camping area.

Many teams enjoy planning and bringing their team food to the shows and you can still do this but with a camper or trailer hook up fee and keep all your feasts appliances, crock pots, and food inside. We hope you will understand that we are not trying to be difficult, but we must be respectful of the facilities that we are using and continue to show there for many years. **Please pass this information along to your teams**. We are looking forward to having great shows that are fun and educational for all our exhibitors.

NRHA Pattern 1



- 1.Run at speed to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
- 2.Run to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
- 3.Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up to center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.
- 4.Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
- 5.Complete four and one-quarter spins to the left so that horse is facing left wall or fence. Hesitate.
- 6.Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 7.Complete three circles to the right: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 8.Begin a large circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run straight up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from wall or fence. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

Horse List

1. **Hobby** (Cornerhouse) - Bay gelding, light contact mostly leg, cluck for jog kiss for lope no spurs required.
2. **Duncan** (Cornerhouse) - Sorrel gelding pony, HT/WT 5'5" – 135#. Cluck for jog, can be ridden with contact, more woah than go, no spurs required. W/T Horse Only.
3. **Stan**: Sorrel POA Gelding (EQD)- Can get quick, hold with quiet rein. Set up for leads. **May** (Ball) need spurs later day.
4. **Marshall**: Appy Gelding (EQD)- Set up & hold into lope transitions. Lots of leg. Set up for right lead. (Ball) Spurs and crop ok.
5. **Sugar** (EQD) Buckskin QH Mare (EQD)- Use soft holding contact on her mouth. Can slow her bouncy trot by softening mouth. Set up for leads. Will go with or without (Ball) spurs.
6. **Cooper** (EQD) - Brown Paint Gelding- Use legs with hand to steer, adjust speed with rein. Lope will build if you let it. Maintain soft hand contact. Good draw. NO spurs.
7. **Cash** (Hickory Ridge) - Works off seat and legs. Sit in saddle, or he will want to move out. Can be lazy. Make sure you get a true gait. Ball spurs ok.
8. **Chip** (Hickory Ridge) - Pleasure type gelding, Neck reins. Encourage with legs to get going. Does best on a loose rein. Nice slow trot when collected up. Walk trot.

11. **Blue**: (Marsha)Sorrel/White Paint Mare Easy ride. Keep in the bridle and will give a good ride. Quiet Firm leg. Spurs ok.
12. **Jess**-(Marsha) Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs
13. **Grinder**- (Marsha) Does all maneuvers well. Needs to be pushed into the bridle and supported to stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.

29. **Ruby** (Southern Ohio) - Appaloosa Mare, (red roan look) light contact, heavy leg, cluck for jog and kiss for lope, set up for leads. Spur according to division.
30. **Rocko** (Southern Ohio) - Bay QH gelding, Maintain light contact, use voice commands and cluck for the jog, kiss for the lope. Spurs ok according to division. HUS type horse, will slow with consistent contact and release. 2 hand option.
31. **Harley** (Turner) - Ranch Type. NO SPURS. Can get antsy in the middle before the start of the pattern. Easy lead changer, and quiet in circles. He does best “slow handed” in stops and roll backs. Deep stopper so let him stop completely before rolling back. Don't ride aggressively and he will stay calm.

NRHA Pattern 2



Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.

2. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.

3. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.

4. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.

5. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (threemeters). Hesitate.

6. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

Horse List

1. **Hobby** (Cornerhouse) - Bay gelding, light contact mostly leg, cluck for jog kiss for lope no spurs required.
2. **Dunkin** (Cornerhouse) - Sorrel gelding pony, HT/WT 5'5" – 135#. Cluck for jog, can be ridden with contact, more woah than go, no spurs required. W/T Horse Only.
3. **Stan**: Sorrel POA Gelding (EQD)- Can get quick, hold with quiet rein. Set up for leads. **May** (Ball) need spurs later day. CROP OPTION
4. **Marshall**: Appy Gelding (EQD)- Set up & hold into lope transitions. Lots of leg. Set up for right lead. (Ball) Spurs and crop ok.
5. **Sugar** (EQD) Buckskin QH Mare (EQD)- Use soft holding contact on her mouth. Can slow her bouncy trot by softening mouth. Set up for leads. Will go with or without (Ball) spurs.
6. **Cooper** (EQD) - Brown Paint Gelding- Use legs with hand to steer, adjust speed with rein. Lope will build if you let it. Maintain soft hand contact. Good draw. NO spurs.
7. **Cash** (Hickory Ridge) - Works off seat and legs. Sit in saddle, or he will want to move out. Can be lazy. Make sure you get a true gait. Ball spurs ok. CROP OPTION
8. **Chip** (Hickory Ridge) - Pleasure type gelding, Neck reins. Encourage with legs to get going. Does best on a loose rein. Nice slow trot when collected up. Walk trot.
9. **Kruiz** (Hickory Ridge) - (Sunday Horse) Nice pleasure mare. Goes on loose rein. Has Spur Stop. Use voice and leg for transitions. Division appropriate spurs.
10. **Jess Too Tempting** (Nat.Champ.) - division appropriate spurs. For walk trot use lots of leg! She takes a lot of leg, especially loping off on the right lead. A little bit of an attitude but pretty easy going. CROP OPTION
11. **Blue**: (Marsha)Sorrel/White Paint Mare Easy ride. Keep in the bridle and will give a good ride. Quiet Firm leg. Spurs ok.
12. **Jess**-(Marsha) Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs
13. **Grinder**- (Marsha) Does all maneuvers well. Needs to be pushed into the bridle and supported to stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.
14. **Gideon** (Royal Creek) – Bay Gelding Spur appropriate all leg - no need to get in his face, cluck to trot, smootch to lope. Flying lead change - very smooth please ask gently no jabbing
15. **Rosie** (Royal Creek) – Sorrell mare QH- retired show horse. great draw, kiss and push opposite leg to lope, cluck to trot. Works off of leg pressure to pivot. Can use any spurs or no spurs - very easy to ride
16. **Ozzie** (Royal Creek) – Bay gelding QH – RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT, KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE CROP OPTION

17. **Jett** (Royal Creek) – BAY GELDING QH - RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT, KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE CROP OPTION
18. **DOC** (Royal Creek) - CHESTNUT GELDING RETIRED SHOW HORSE KNOWS HIS JOB WORKS OFF LEGS CLUCK TO TROT KISS TO LOPE . DON'T TIGHTEN REINS TOO MUCH / RANCH RIDING DELUXE
19. **Chip** (Royal Creek) – BAY QH GELDING ; SWEET HORSE – CLUCK TO TROT CROP OPTION
20. **Kirby** (Royal Creek) – QH BAY GELDING – WORKS OFF LEG PRESSURE – CLUCK TO TROT; KISS TO LOPE
21. **GIGI** (Royal Creek) BAY QH MARE – WALK TOT ONLY : KNOWS HER JOB GREAT DRAW / CLUCK TO TROT
22. **Laredo** (Royal Creek) – PAINT GELDING – SWEET HORSE– RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE
23. **Red** (Royal Creek) – SORRELL GELDING QH – HIGH HEADED BUT SMOOTH TROT AND LOPE LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT
24. **Jose** (Royal Creek) – BAY GELDING GENTLE GIANT – WALK TROT ONLY RETIRED SHOW HORSE / PERFECT IN EVERY WAY: CLUCK TO TROT AMAZING DRAW CROP OPTION
25. **Cooper** (Royal Creek) - BAY GELDING – RETIRED SHOW HORSE – GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT, KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE
26. **Jett** (Southern Ohio) – Black Gelding, lots of leg, light hands, click to jog, kiss to lope, can be lazy, use lots of spur. Rowel Spurs needed. Spur trained, will do a flying lead change. CROP OPTION
27. **Smartie** - (Southern Ohio) - Sorrel QH gelding. Use very light cues, voice commands. Maintain contact and set up for leads. No spurs.
28. **Ali** (Southern Ohio) - Bay QH mare. Maintain light contact, use voice commands and cluck for the jog, kiss for the lope. Spurs ok according to division. HUS type horse, will slow with consistent contact and release. 2 hand option.
29. **Ruby** (Southern Ohio) - Appaloosa Mare, (red roan look) light contact, heavy leg, cluck for jog and kiss for lope, set up for leads. Spur according to division.
30. **Rocko** (Southern Ohio) - Bay QH gelding, Maintain light contact, use voice commands and cluck for the jog, kiss for the lope. Spurs ok according to division. HUS type horse, will slow with consistent contact and release. 2 hand option.
31. **Harley** (Turner) - Ranch Type. NO SPURS. Can get antsy in the middle before the start of the pattern. Easy lead changer, and quiet in circles. He does best “slow handed” in stops and roll backs. Deep stopper so let him stop completely before rolling back. Don't ride aggressively and he will stay calm.
