Electric Policy & Camping

YEDA will adhere to a very strict policy for all YEDA show; **“No one can plug anything into any facility outlet”**. If a team or individual needs to plug in a truck, trailer or camper a hookup fee will be charged, which must be paid ahead of time in the YEDA office, once paid a permit will be given as proof of purchase. **Hook up fees are \$30 per night, this is for each outlet (trucks and campers)**. Generators are prohibited in and near the arena. You are welcome to bring a camper or horse trailer and park it in the camping area to house your generator and the items you plan to run off your generator. There will be a \$100 fine for generators outside designated areas or for plugging items in not in the camping area.

Many teams enjoy planning and bringing their team food to the shows and you can still do this but with a camper or trailer hook up fee and keep all your feasts appliances, crock pots, and food inside. We hope you will understand that we are not trying to be difficult, but we must be respectful of the facilities that we are using and continue to show there for many years. **Please pass this information along to your teams**. We are looking forward to having great shows that are fun and educational for all our exhibitors.

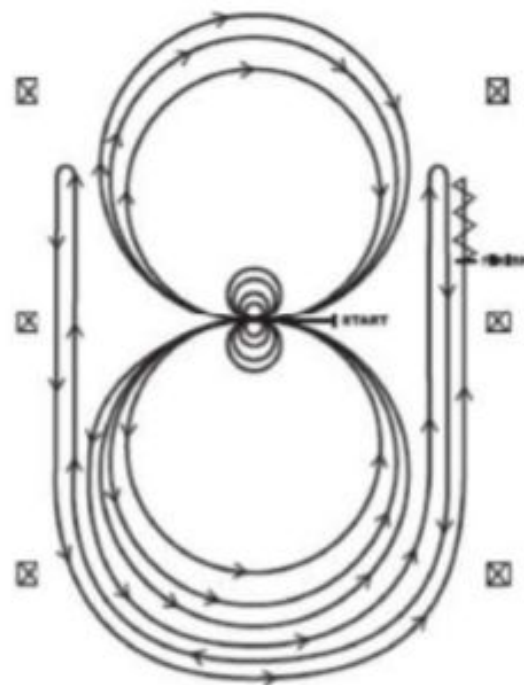

Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

2. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.

3. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.

4. Complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.

5. Begin a large circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.

6. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.

7. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

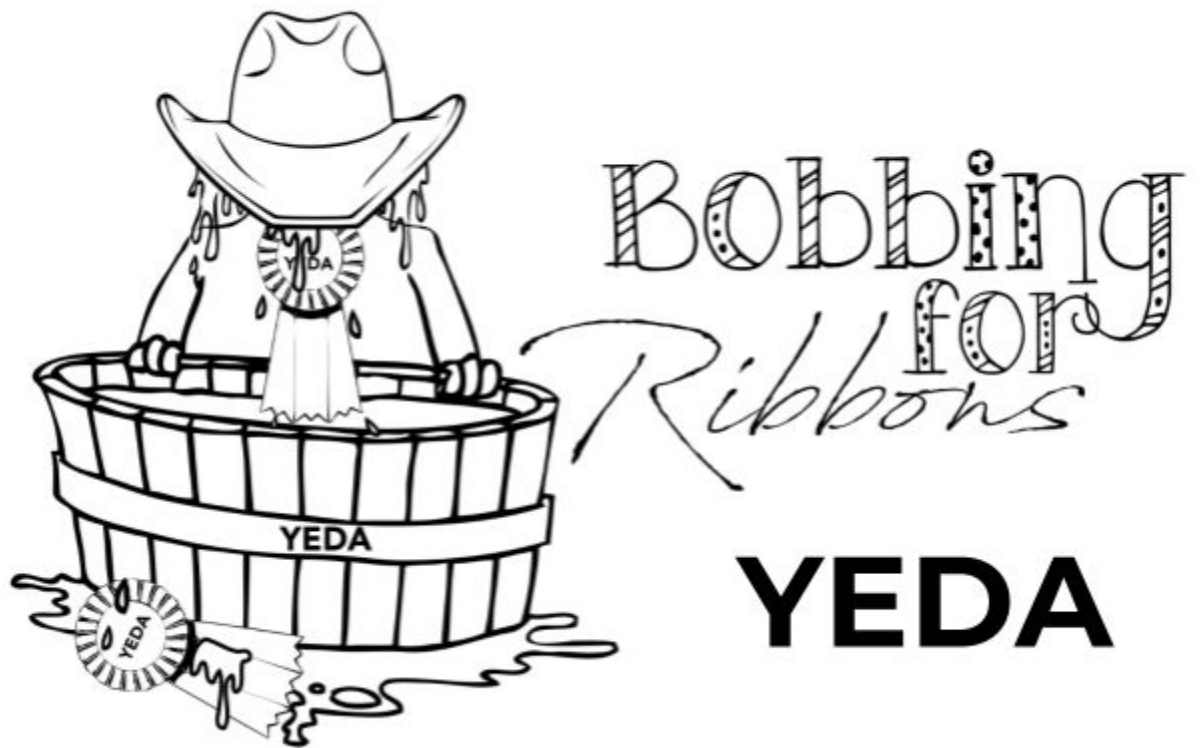

Horse Descriptions

1. **Gator** (Hancock) Palomino QH, Reiner type. Leg release stop. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Light contact with bit. Honest, great draw.
2. **Milo** (Hancock) Reiner, Hold during run downs in reining. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Leg release stop. Honest; great draw.
3. **Izzy** (Hancock) no spurs ranch type let her have a little forward do not over bridle has lead change
4. **Misty** (Hancock)ball spurs reining ranch type will jog and lope slow set up for right lead don't over bridle has lead change
5. **Flannel** (Hancock) no spurs big guy but goes nowhere honest smooth ride won't frame in face. good for any level
6. **Eric** (Hancock) – Reiner type. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Lazy use leg contact to keep true gaits. Will over bridle easy, so really light hands and light rein contact. Honest good draw.
7. **Fiat** (Hancock) - Slight rein contact, will not bridle up. Ranch type horse. She is a little more forward but goes nowhere, set up for leads. No spurs.
8. **Macy** - Bay QH, Good Draw. Light rein contact can hold don't trap or over-bridle. Ride relaxed in seat and legs and she will be relaxed.
9. **Remi**- Sorrel Quarter Horse Mare. Good draw. Ride with light contact. Has a leg release stop. Set up for leads. Great pattern horse. To slow down release your legs off of her, but not so much she will stop. Do not squeeze to slow her down, it will make her go faster. Use level appropriate spurs but do not over use spur.
10. **Chester**- Chestnut Quarter Horse Gelding. Good draw. Stay relaxed on him. Can ride with light contact. Easy draw and great pattern horse. Squeeze to slow down and kiss to lope off. Talk to him when you stop and break down to trot or walk. Ball spurs preferred but can use rowel.
11. **Raisin**- Bay Quarter Horse Gelding. Good, easy draw. Ride with some contact. Squeeze to slow him down. Will neck rein, but use legs to help guide him around. Can be lazy when asked to trot. Walk trot only. Can use crop if having lazy day.
12. **Red** (Marc Gellart/Hancock): good draw reiner type. Leg release stop. Will jog but not slow like pleasure horse. Can use division appropriate spurs.
13. **Jess Too Temp** (Nat. Champ) - division appropriate spurs. For walk trot use lots of leg! She takes a lot of leg, especially loping off on the right lead. A little bit of an attitude but pretty easy going.
14. **Rocky** (McColley) - Light contact or he won't go, needs spurs and is spur trained; should be fine at the gate.

15. **Joker** (McColley) - Spurs or crop will be needed. Forward mover, super safe! Medium contact
16. **Jett** (Southern Ohio) – Black Gelding, lots of leg, light hands, click to jog, kiss to lope, can be lazy, use lots of spur. Rowel Spurs needed. Spur trained, will do a flying lead change.
17. **Coco** (Southern Ohio) – Bay Gelding, use quiet hands, light contact, use lots of leg, cluck for jog and kiss for lope, will respond to spur stop or neck rein, spurs (ball or rowel) allowed. Spur trained, will do a flying lead change.
18. **Ruby** (Southern Ohio) - Appaloosa Mare, (red roan look) light contact, heavy leg, cluck for jog and kiss for lope, set up for leads. Spur according to division.
19. **Blue:** (Marcia)Sorrel/White Paint Mare Easy ride. Keep in the bridle and will give a good ride. Quiet Firm leg. Spurs ok.
20. **Jess-**(Marcia) Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs
21. **Grinder-** (Marcia) Does all maneuvers well. Needs to be pushed into the bridle and supported to stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.
22. **Moon** (EQD) - Bay QH Gelding Can get lazy. May carry crop, but use kindly. Set up for leads. Spurs ok.
23. **Rusty** (EQD) - Draft X Set up for right lead. Keep mouth contact. Lots of legs for lope and steering. Spurs & crop ok.
24. **Melody** (EQD) - Red Dun QH mare. Needs ridden with contact but not a lot of bit pressure. Support with leg for lope. Spurs needed for lope.
25. **Squirt** (Timmermans) - Great Walk Trot horse. Loose reins, pretty responsive with your legs. No Spurs or crop.
26. **Big Shot** (Timmermans) -15' 3 hand gelding, steady eddie horse. Great Draw. Set up for right lead, turn head until he has picked up the lead. No Spurs, No Crop!
27. **Ringo** (Timmermans) Ringo height/weight horse 14'1" tall. Very cinchy. Super trained, very responsive. Loose reins and soft legs. No spurs or crop
28. **Rawhide** (Timmermans) - is a walk trot horse. Loose reins, can be lazy so you may need to kick a little bit. Super smooth. No spurs or crop.
29. **Henry** (Timmermans) - is a walk trot horse. Loose reins, can be lazy so you may need to kick a little bit. Su is a ranch horse. Spring loaded jog, smooth lope likes leg contact needs to be reminded to collect but good mannered. Spins and does flying lead changes. May use ball spurs.

6. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
7. Complete three circles to the right: the first circle large and fast; the second circle small and slow; the third circle large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
8. Begin a large circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run straight up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from wall or fence. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions

1. **Gator** (Hancock) Palomino QH, Reiner type. Leg release stop. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Light contact with bit. Honest, great draw.
2. **Milo** (Hancock) Reiner, Hold during run downs in reining. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Leg release stop. Honest; great draw.
3. **Izzy** (Hancock) no spurs ranch type let her have a little forward do not over bridle has lead change
4. **Misty** (Hancock)ball spurs reining ranch type will jog and lope slow set up for right lead don't over bridle has lead change
5. **Flannel** (Hancock) no spurs big guy but goes nowhere honest smooth ride won't frame in face. good for any level
6. **Eric** (Hancock) – Reiner type. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Lazy use leg contact to keep true gaits. Will over bridle easy, so really light hands and light rein contact. Honest good draw.
7. **Fiat** (Hancock) - Slight rein contact, will not bridle up. Ranch type horse. She is a little more forward but goes nowhere, set up for leads. No spurs.
8. **Macy** - Bay QH, Good Draw. Light rein contact can hold don't trap or over-bridle. Ride relaxed in seat and legs and she will be relaxed.
9. **Remi**- Sorrel Quarter Horse Mare. Good draw. Ride with light contact. Has a leg release stop. Set up for leads. Great pattern horse. To slow down release your legs off of her, but not so much she will stop. Do not squeeze to slow her down, it will make her go faster. Use level appropriate spurs but do not over use spur.
10. **Chester**- Chestnut Quarter Horse Gelding. Good draw. Stay relaxed on him. Can ride with light contact. Easy draw and great pattern horse. Squeeze to slow down and kiss to lope off. Talk to him when you stop and break down to trot or walk. Ball spurs preferred but can use rowel.
11. **Raisin**- Bay Quarter Horse Gelding. Good, easy draw. Ride with some contact. Squeeze to slow him down. Will neck rein, but use legs to help guide him around. Can be lazy when asked to trot. Walk trot only. Can use crop if having lazy day.
12. **Red** (Marc Gellart/Hancock): good draw reiner type. Leg release stop. Will jog but not slow like pleasure horse. Can use division appropriate spurs.
13. **Jess Too Temp** (Nat. Champ) - division appropriate spurs. For walk trot use lots of leg! She takes a lot of leg, especially loping off on the right lead. A little bit of an attitude but pretty easy going.
14. **Rocky** (McColley) - Light contact or he won't go, needs spurs and is spur trained; should be fine at the gate.
15. **Joker** (McColley) - Spurs or crop will be needed. Forward mover, super safe! Medium contact
16. **Jett** (Southern Ohio) – Black Gelding, lots of leg, light hands, click to jog, kiss to lope, can be lazy, use lots of spur. Rowel Spurs needed. Spur trained, will do a flying lead change.

17. **Coco** (Southern Ohio) – Bay Gelding, use quiet hands, light contact, use lots of leg, cluck for jog and kiss for lope, will respond to spur stop or neck rein, spurs (ball or rowel) allowed. Spur trained, will do a flying lead change.
18. **Ruby** (Southern Ohio) - Appaloosa Mare, (red roan look) light contact, heavy leg, cluck for jog and kiss for lope, set up for leads. Spur according to division.
19. **Blue:** (Marcia)Sorrel/White Paint Mare Easy ride. Keep in the bridle and will give a good ride. Quiet Firm leg. Spurs ok.
20. **Jess-**(Marcia) Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs
21. **Grinder-** (Marcia) Does all maneuvers well. Needs to be pushed into the bridle and supported to stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.
22. **Moon** (EQD) - Bay QH Gelding Can get lazy. May carry crop, but use kindly. Set up for leads. Spurs ok.
23. **Rusty** (EQD) - Draft X Set up for right lead. Keep mouth contact. Lots of legs for lope and steering. Spurs & crop ok.
24. **Melody** (EQD) - Red Dun QH mare. Needs ridden with contact but not a lot of bit pressure. Support with leg for lope. Spurs needed for lope.
25. **Squirt** (Timmermans) - Great Walk Trot horse. Loose reins, pretty responsive with your legs. No Spurs or crop.
26. **Big Shot** (Timmermans) -15' 3 hand gelding, steady eddie horse. Great Draw. Set up for right lead, turn head until he has picked up the lead. No Spurs, No Crop!
27. **Ringo** (Timmermans) Ringo height/weight horse 14'1" tall. Very cinchy. Super trained, very responsive. Loose reins and soft legs. No spurs or crop
28. **Rawhide** (Timmermans) - is a walk trot horse. Loose reins, can be lazy so you may need to kick a little bit. Super smooth. No spurs or crop.
29. **Henry** (Timmermans) - is a walk trot horse. Loose reins, can be lazy so you may need to kick a little bit. Su is a ranch horse. Spring loaded jog, smooth lope likes leg contact needs to be reminded to collect but good mannered. Spins and does flying lead changes. May use ball spurs.
30. **Rosie** (Royal Creek) – **SUNDAY ONLY** Sorrell mare QH- retired show horse. great draw, kiss and push opposite leg to lope, cluck to trot. Works off of leg pressure to pivot. Can use any spurs or no spurs - very easy to ride
31. **Ozzie** (Royal Creek) – **SUNDAY ONLY** Bay gelding QH – RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT, KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE
32. **Jett** (Royal Creek) – **SUNDAY ONLY** BAY GELDING QH - RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT, KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE
