Electric Policy!

YEDA will adhere to a very strict policy for the rest of YEDA show season **“No one can plug anything into any facility outlet”**. If a team or individual needs to plug in a truck, trailer or camper a hookup fee will be charged, which must be paid ahead of time in the YEDA office, once paid a permit will be given as proof of purchase. Hook up fees vary depending on location and charged per night. Generators are prohibited in and near the arena. You are welcome to bring a camper or horse trailer and park it in the camping area to house your generator and the items you plan to run off your generator. There will be a \$100 fine for generators outside designated areas or for plugging items in not in the camping area.

Many teams enjoy planning and bringing their team food to the shows and you can still do this but with a camper or trailer hook up fee and keep all your feasts appliances, crock pots, and food inside. We hope you will understand that we are not trying to be difficult but we must be respectful of the facilities that we are using and continue to show there for many years. Please pass this information along to your teams. We are looking forward to having great shows that are fun and educational for all our exhibitors.

1. Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
2. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate.
3. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Stop at the center of the arena. Hesitate.
4. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
5. Beginning on the left lead, run a large fast circle to the left, change leads at the center of the arena, run large fast circle to the right, and change leads at the center of the arena. (Figure 8)
6. Continue around previous circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
7. Continue around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
8. Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions

1. **Forrest** (Arnold) - Sorrel Paint Gelding Light Rein contact. Rowel or Ball Spurs depending on division. Use hand and leg to support into lope transition and to collect on rail. Has spur stop for patterns
2. **Freddie** (Arnold) - Bay QH gelding. Light contact. No Spurs.
3. **Sissy** (Arnold) - Light rein contact, support with hand and use leg to collect. Spurs ok. Set up for right lead. Hand to rail and push hip in.
4. **Gabby** (Arnold) - Light rein contact, bump with hand if use leg to collect. Spurs ok.
5. **King** (Buckeye) - **SUNDAY ONLY** Ball or Rowl spurs, Reiner, smooth hand, do not drag. Keep him circling. Will look to change leads early.
6. **Hollywood** (Buckeye) - **SUNDAY ONLY** Ball or Rowl spurs, Reiner, Don't override. She may get strong on run downs, steady her down the pen and ask (don't pull/make) her stop.
7. **Blue:** (Marcia) Sorrel/White Paint Mare Easy ride. Keep in the bridle and will give a good ride. Quiet Firm leg. Spurs ok.
8. **Jess-**(Marcia) Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs
9. **Grinder-** (Marcia) Does all maneuvers well. Needs to be pushed into the bridle and supported to stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.
10. **Junior** (EQD) Bay QH Gelding- Keep collected and will give a good ride. Firm leg. Spurs ok.
11. **Stan** (EQD) Sorrel POA Gelding - Can get quick, hold with quiet rein. Set up for leads. May need spurs later day.
12. **Sugar** (EQD) Buckskin QH Mare- Use soft holding contact on her mouth. Can slow her bouncy trot by softening mouth. Set up for leads. Will go with or without spurs.
13. **Cooper** (EQD) Brown Paint Gelding- Use legs with hand to steer, adjust speed with rein. Lope will build if you let it. Maintain soft hand contact. Good draw. NO spurs.
14. **Marshall** (EQD) Appy Gelding - Set up & hold into lope transitions. Lots of leg. Set up for right lead. Spurs and crop ok.
15. **Moon** (EQD) **SATURDAY ONLY** Bay QH Gelding Can get lazy. May carry crop, but use kindly. Set up for leads. Spurs ok.
16. **Rusty**(EQD) Draft X - Set up for right lead. Keep mouth contact. Lots of legs
17. **Chester** (Hancock) Chestnut Quarter Horse Gelding. Good draw. Stay relaxed on him. Can ride with light contact. Easy draw and great pattern horse. Squeeze to slow down and kiss to lope off. Talk to him when you stop and break down to trot or walk. Ball spurs preferred but can use rowel.
18. **Remi** (Hancock) Sorrel Quarter Horse Mare. Good draw. Ride with light contact. Has a leg release stop. Set up for leads. Great pattern horse. To slow down release your legs off of her, but not so much she will stop. Do not squeeze to slow her down, it will make her go faster. Use level appropriate spurs but do not over use spur.
19. **Rasin** (Hancock) Bay Quarter Horse Gelding. Good, easy draw. Ride with some contact. Squeeze to slow him down. Will neck rein, but use legs to help guide him around. Can be lazy when asked to trot. Walk trot only. Can use crop if having lazy day.
20. **Milo** (Hancock) Reiner, Hold during run downs in reining. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Leg release stop. Honest; great draw.
21. **Gator** (Hancock) Palomino QH, Reiner type. Leg release stop. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Light contact with bit. Honest, great draw.
22. **Flannel** (Hancock) no spurs big guy but goes nowhere honest smooth ride won't frame in face. good for any level

23. **Red** (Marc Gellart/Hancock): good draw reiner type. Leg release stop. Will jog but not slow like pleasure horse. Can use division appropriate spurs.
24. **Izzy** (Hancock) ranch type let her have a little forward do not over bridle has lead change, may need ball spurs as the day unfolds. Please check with steward throughout the day.
25. **Macy** Bay QH, Good Draw. Light rein contact can hold don't trap or over-bridle. Ride relaxed in seat and legs and she will be relaxed
26. **Diesel** (Hancock) - Ride with lots of leg, requires a lot of leg to keep encouraging to move forward, use light to medium contact. Use legs along with neck reining in turns and circles. To stop sit deep and take your legs off. Responds well to voice cues. Very bouncy. Ball Spurs or crop are fine. Two hand option.
27. **Annabelle** - (Hancock)-Haflinger Pony. Walk Trot only. Good Draw. Easy to ride. Can have rein contact but do not trap.
28. **Andy** (Hancock) - Great draw! Does best if the rein is a little looser, stay out of his face. Ball spurs ok, easy to set up for leads.
29. **Scotch** (KCPH) - Quiet and Willing for any rider. Best if kept in bridle. Use legs, has a spur stop. Must use outside leg well for lope as he will only go as much as you ask him. Ball Spurs only to start
30. **Fred** (KCPH) - Walk jog only. Has a spur stop. Can get lazy at times, just use legs and voice. Has a weight limit as he is elderly.
31. **Lacey** (KCPH)- Walk jog only, Light contact in face, no spur stop. Pick up and use firm leg if need to turn
32. **Rocky** (McColley) - Light contact or he won't go needs spurs and is spur trained; should be fine at the gate.
33. **Joker** (McColley) - Spurs or crop will be needed, forward mover but super safe, medium contact.
34. **Cindi** (McColley) - Medium contact, soft cues, no spurs.
35. **Belle** (McColley) - Two handed, spurs based on division. Quiet young horse - must set up for leads.
36. **LJ** (McColley) - Will go with or without spurs, appropriate for all divisions, light rein contact and make sure to use legs before hand, light spurs. Division appropriate spurs.
37. **Jess Too Temp** (National Champ) - division appropriate spurs. For walk trot use lots of leg! She takes a lot of leg, especially loping off on the right lead. A little bit of an attitude but pretty easy going.
38. **Ozzie** (Royal Creek) Bay gelding QH – RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT, KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE
39. **Rosie** (Royal Creek) Sorrell mare QH- retired show horse. great draw, kiss and push opposite leg to lope, cluck to trot. Works off of leg pressure to pivot. Can use any spurs or no spurs - very easy to ride
40. **Harley** (Royal Creek) - Ranch Type. NO SPURS. Can get antsy in the middle before the start of the pattern. Easy lead changer, and quiet in circles. He does best "slow handed" in stops and roll backs. Deep stopper so let him stop completely before rolling back. Don't ride aggressively and he will stay calm.
41. **Apple** - (Circle M) 5'5" 135# height/weight, pony 13 hands, easy draw, can use spurs in appropriate divisions, backs crooked
42. **Jerl** -(Circle M) Reiner type, can be used in all divisions he is quiet enough just really bouncy jog. Spurs can be used, easy but can get forward in patterns if not controlled well
43. **Sarge** - (Circle M) Black and white paint, spurs should not be needed, but if they are then ball spurs only. Should be easy to ride. 2 hand option. Black and white paint, no spurs, should be easy to ride. 2 hand option.

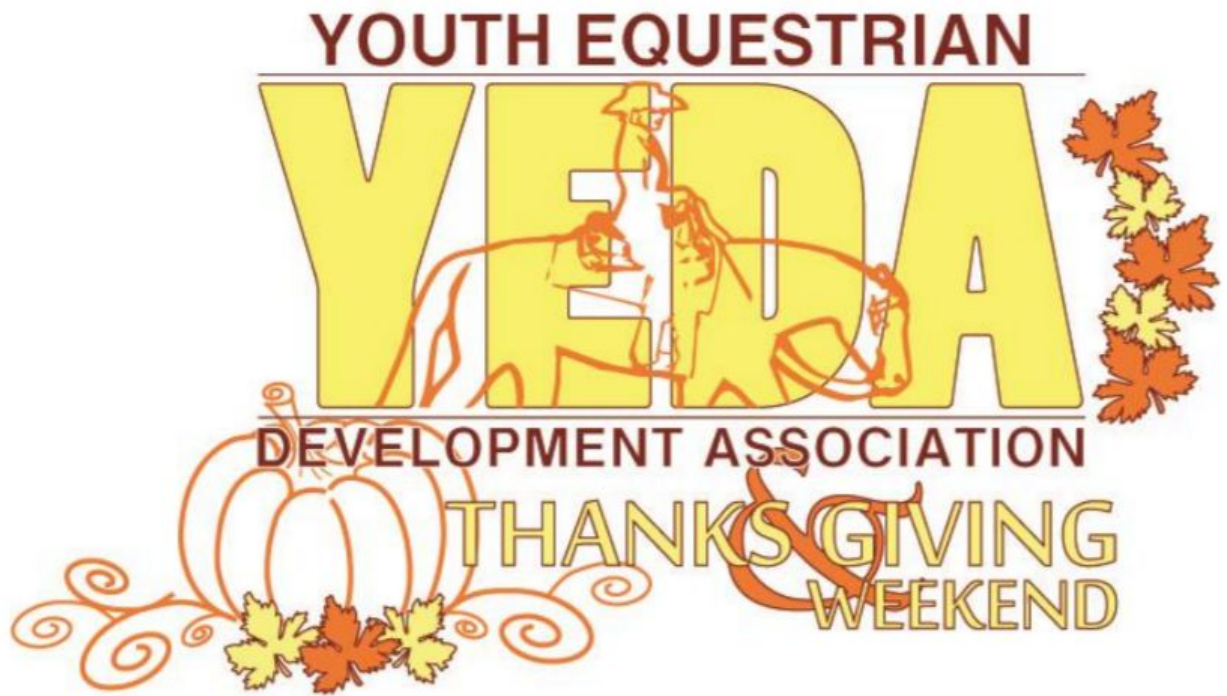

YEDA will adhere to a very strict policy for the rest of YEDA show season **"No one can plug anything into any facility outlet"**. If a team or individual needs to plug in a truck, trailer or camper a hookup fee will be charged, which must be paid ahead of time in the YEDA office, once paid a permit will be given as proof of purchase. Hook up fees vary depending on location and charged per night. Generators are prohibited in and near the arena. There will be a \$100 fine for generators outside designated areas or for plugging items in not in the camping area.

Horses may walk or jog to the center of arena. Horses must walk or stop prior to starting pattern. Beginning at the center of the arena facing the left wall or fence.

1. Beginning on the right lead, complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.

2. Complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.

3. Continue around previous circle to the right. At the top of the circle, run down the middle to the far end of the arena past the end marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.

4. Run up the middle to the opposite end of the arena past the end marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.

5. Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (threemeters). Hesitate.

6. Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.

7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate the completion of the pattern.

Horse Descriptions

44. **Forrest** (Arnold) - Sorrel Paint Gelding Light Rein contact. Rowel or Ball Spurs depending on division. Use hand and leg to support into lope transition and to collect on rail. Has spur stop for patterns
45. **Freddie** (Arnold) - Bay QH gelding. Light contact. No Spurs.
46. **Sissy** (Arnold) - Light rein contact, support with hand and use leg to collect. Spurs ok. Set up for right lead. Hand to rail and push hip in.
47. **Gabby** (Arnold) - Light rein contact, bump with hand if use leg to collect. Spurs ok.
48. **King** (Buckeye) - **SUNDAY ONLY** Ball or Rowl spurs, Reiner, smooth hand, do not drag. Keep him circling. Will look to change leads early.
49. **Hollywood** (Buckeye) - **SUNDAY ONLY** Ball or Rowl spurs, Reiner, Don't override. She may get strong on run downs, steady her down the pen and ask (don't pull/make) her stop.
50. **Blue:** (Marcia) Sorrel/White Paint Mare Easy ride. Keep in the bridle and will give a good ride. Quiet Firm leg. Spurs ok.
51. **Jess-**(Marcia) Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs
52. **Grinder-** (Marcia) Does all maneuvers well. Needs to be pushed into the bridle and supported to stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.
53. **Junior** (EQD) Bay QH Gelding- Keep collected and will give a good ride. Firm leg. Spurs ok.
54. **Stan** (EQD) Sorrel POA Gelding - Can get quick, hold with quiet rein. Set up for leads. May need spurs later day.
55. **Sugar** (EQD) Buckskin QH Mare- Use soft holding contact on her mouth. Can slow her bouncy trot by softening mouth. Set up for leads. Will go with or without spurs.
56. **Cooper** (EQD) Brown Paint Gelding- Use legs with hand to steer, adjust speed with rein. Lope will build if you let it. Maintain soft hand contact. Good draw. NO spurs.
57. **Marshall** (EQD) Appy Gelding - Set up & hold into lope transitions. Lots of leg. Set up for right lead. Spurs and crop ok.
58. **Moon** (EQD) **SATURDAY ONLY** Bay QH Gelding Can get lazy. May carry crop, but use kindly. Set up for leads. Spurs ok.
59. **Rusty**(EQD) Draft X - Set up for right lead. Keep mouth contact. Lots of legs
60. **Chester** Chestnut Quarter Horse Gelding. Good draw. Stay relaxed on him. Can ride with light contact. Easy draw and great pattern horse. Squeeze to slow down and kiss to lope off. Talk to him when you stop and break down to trot or walk. Ball spurs preferred but can use rowel.
61. **Remi** Sorrel Quarter Horse Mare. Good draw. Ride with light contact. Has a leg release stop. Set up for leads. Great pattern horse. To slow down release your legs off of her, but not so much she will stop. Do not squeeze to slow her down, it will make her go faster. Use level appropriate spurs but do not over use spur.
62. **Rasin** Bay Quarter Horse Gelding. Good, easy draw. Ride with some contact. Squeeze to slow him down. Will neck rein, but use legs to help guide him around. Can be lazy when asked to trot. Walk trot only. Can use crop if having lazy day.
63. **Milo** (Hancock) Reiner, Hold during run downs in reining. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Leg release stop. Honest; great draw.
64. **Gator** (Hancock) Palomino QH, Reiner type. Leg release stop. Spurs ok for division appropriate classes. Good in walk trot with no spurs. Light contact with bit. Honest, great draw.
65. **Flannel** (Hancock) no spurs big guy but goes nowhere honest smooth ride won't frame in face. good for any level

66. **Red** (Marc Gellart/Hancock): good draw reiner type. Leg release stop. Will jog but not slow like pleasure horse. Can use division appropriate spurs.
67. **Izzy** (Hancock) ranch type let her have a little forward do not over bridle has lead change, may need ball spurs as the day unfolds. Please check with steward throughout the day.
68. **Macy** Bay QH, Good Draw. Light rein contact can hold don't trap or over-bridle. Ride relaxed in seat and legs and she will be relaxed
69. **Diesel** (Hancock) - Ride with lots of leg, requires a lot of leg to keep encouraging to move forward, use light to medium contact. Use legs along with neck reining in turns and circles. To stop sit deep and take your legs off. Responds well to voice cues. Very bouncy. Ball Spurs or crop are fine. Two hand option.
70. **Annabelle** - (Hancock)-Haflinger Pony. Walk Trot only. Good Draw. Easy to ride. Can have rein contact but do not trap.
71. **Andy** (Hancock) - Great draw! Does best if the rein is a little looser, stay out of his face. Ball spurs ok, easy to set up for leads.
72. **Scotch** (KCPH) - Quiet and Willing for any rider. Best if kept in bridle. Use legs, has a spur stop. Must use outside leg well for lope as he will only go as much as you ask him. Ball Spurs only to start
73. **Fred** (KCPH) - Walk jog only. Has a spur stop. Can get lazy at times, just use legs and voice. Has a weight limit as he is elderly.
74. **Lacey** (KCPH)- Walk jog only, Light contact in face, no spur stop. Pick up and use firm leg if need to turn
75. **Rocky** (McColley) - Light contact or he won't go needs spurs and is spur trained; should be fine at the gate.
76. **Joker** (McColley) - Spurs or crop will be needed, forward mover but super safe, medium contact.
77. **Cindi** (McColley) - Medium contact, soft cues, no spurs.
78. **Belle** (McColley) - Two handed, spurs based on division. Quiet young horse - must set up for leads.
79. **LJ** (McColley) - Will go with or without spurs, appropriate for all divisions, light rein contact and make sure to use legs before hand, light spurs. Division appropriate spurs.
80. **Jess Too Temp** (National Champ) - division appropriate spurs. For walk trot use lots of leg! She takes a lot of leg, especially loping off on the right lead. A little bit of an attitude but pretty easy going.
81. **Ozzie** (Royal Creek) Bay gelding QH – RETIRED SHOW HORSE – BABYSITTER GREAT DRAW – CLUCK TO TROT, KISS TO LOPE, WORKS OFF OF LEG PRESSURE TO PIVOT – CAN USE SPURS OR NO SPURS – VERY EASY TO RIDE
82. **Rosie** (Royal Creek) Sorrell mare QH- retired show horse. great draw, kiss and push opposite leg to lope, cluck to trot. Works off of leg pressure to pivot. Can use any spurs or no spurs - very easy to ride
83. **Harley** (Royal Creek) - Ranch Type. NO SPURS. Can get antsy in the middle before the start of the pattern. Easy lead changer, and quiet in circles. He does best "slow handed" in stops and roll backs. Deep stopper so let him stop completely before rolling back. Don't ride aggressively and he will stay calm.
84. **Apple** - (Circle M) 5'5" 135# height/weight, pony 13 hands, easy draw, can use spurs in appropriate divisions, backs crooked
85. **Jerl** -(Circle M) Reiner type, can be used in all divisions he is quiet enough just really bouncy jog. Spurs can be used, easy but can get forward in patterns if not controlled well
86. **Sarge** - (Circle M) Black and white paint, spurs should not be needed, but if they are then ball spurs only. Should be easy to ride. 2 hand option. Black and white paint, no spurs, should be easy to ride. 2 hand option.
