YEDA Nationals Plan to Protect Against Covid-19

What we know

- There is currently no vaccine to prevent coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19).
- The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus.
- The virus is thought to spread mainly from person-to-person.
 - o Between people who are in close contact with one another (within about 6 feet).
 - Through respiratory droplets produced when an infected person coughs, sneezes or talks.
 - These droplets can land in the mouths or noses of people who are nearby or possibly be inhaled into the lungs.
 - Some recent studies have suggested that COVID-19 may be spread by people who are not showing symptoms.

What we are doing

- Following and respecting the CDC guidelines
- Limiting spectators and social distancing
- Cleaning AND disinfecting all frequently touched surfaces (show office, restrooms, etc.)
- Hand sanitizers will be placed everywhere throughout the show facility and available at all times
- If anyone shows any visible signs/symptoms (fatigue, audible cough, or signs of fever) they will be asked to go home.
- Paddock Area and Mounting: We are requiring each rider to use hand sanitizer prior to mounting and then hand sanitizer immediately after dismounting.
- No Live Horse Draw: coaches and the stewards will conduct the draw
- Double tables for vendors: creating a 6 foot distance between people
- Awards Handouts: only the queen will hand out awards and will be wearing rubber gloves
- Photos: No group photos, set up 6' distance board to utilize
- Each team will have a designated "dressing stall" equipt with hand sanitizer
- Everyone is encouraged to wear a face cover. The cloth face cover is meant to protect other
 people in case you are infected. The only exception is while a rider is showing, because they
 will be social distancing while on their horses for safety. Please bring your own face covering
 as YEDA will not be providing these.

How spectators and riders can help

- If you are feeling ill or have been exposed to COVID-19 PLEASE STAY HOME
- Check your temp prior to coming, if it is over 100.4, please stay home
- Limit Spectators; we ask that the rider and only 2 additional people come to the show
- No Food Tables or community shares
- Put distance between yourself and other people, Stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arms' length) from other people.
- Seating area: respect 6' distance.
- Follow signs and directions implemented at the show
