

#### YEDA PLAN TO PROTECT AGAINST COVID-19

Fall 2020



- There is currently no vaccine to prevent coronavirus (Covid 19)
- The best way to prevent illness is to avoid being exposed to this virus
- The virus is thought to spread mainly person to person
- It can be spread between people who are within close contact with one another and through respiratory droplets when an infected person coughs, sneezes, or talks.

#### What YEDA is Doing

- Following and respecting all CDC Guidelines
- Following and respecting all State and local health guidelines
- Limiting spectators and social distancing
- Allowing shows to be double judges so that only half of the riders need to be present on a day in the arena but riders can still receive two judges points
- Placing hand sanitizer throughout the show facility and available at all times
  - Office
    - Food booth
    - Paddock
- If any individual at a YEDA show displays visible symptoms of COVID 19, they will be required to leave the show premises by show management immediately and not return to the facility. Show management must enforce this strictly
- We are requiring each rider to use hand sanitizer prior to mounting and immediately after dismounting
- There will be designated mounting spots for each draw number to keep the paddock organized
- There will be strictly enforced limiting of the number of coaches and riders in the paddock at any given time
- Social distancing will be achieved by spacing out horses and horse holders as much as each facility allows
- Horses not in the next class can be held in separate area if the show facility allows
- No live horse draws Steward will conduct the draw with coaches witnessing
- Double tables to be provided for all vendors to allow for social distancing
- Only one person will hand out awards and that person will use hand sanitizer between each class
- Require teams to not have riders and parents at the show if they are not actively showing or needed to hold horses
- The majority of YEDA apparel sales will be done online to limit contact
- Masks are required indoors where social distancing cannot be achieved
  - Masks are not required while riding or showing a horse
  - o If you have a health condition and cannot wear a mask, please turn in documentation to the show office

#### How Spectators and Riders Can Help

- If you feel ill or have been exposed to COVID-19, you MUST stay home
- Check our temperature prior to attending a YEDA event: if it is over 100.4 you MUST stay home
- Spectators, coaches, vendors, staff and riders must wear face masks when indoors where social distancing cannot be achieved.
  - o Riders may go without face masks immediately before their class, while mounting and while showing
  - A trash can for disposable masks will be located in the paddock for riders to dispose of their mask before riding
- Limit Spectators: we require that only 1 parent accompany a rider to a YEDA show if possible to limit the total number of people at the shows. Please no additional friends and family members as spectators.
- NO team food tables or community share tables will be allowed at the show
- Put a minimum of 6-foot distance between yourself and others whenever possible. If social distancing cannot be achieved, wear a face mask.
- Respect 6-foot distance in the seating area by sitting 3 seats away from anyone not in your group at all times
- Be respectful of new rules and guidelines and understand that for everyone's safety YEDA shows will look different this season
- Understand that this a fluid situation and be flexible to adjust to changes as they happen
- Listen to YEDA staff and follow all relevant instructions so that we can show while still maintaining the health and safety of all involved. Cooperation is mandatory and blatant disregard of the YEDA COVID rules will not be tolerated.

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Our mission is to provide an equestrian riding program for youth students, via both instructional and experiential learning opportunities. To accomplish this, we will engage in equestrian competitions, instructional clinics, networking events and occasions for recruitment that includes but not limited to scholarship disbursements.

#### Entry Information, Deadlines, and Scratch Refund Policy:

Entries will not be accepted without payment.

- Open date for entries is February 18, 2021
- The due date for entries is (<u>March 19, 2021)</u>
- Entries **received** after the due date may not be accepted.
- Entries are \$40 per class. **Plus a \$5 Office Fee.**
- The maximum number of entries for this show is 275 rides.
- In the event that the maximum entries are reached entries will be accepted on a first come basis. Meaning that entries will only be considered accepted once originals are received with horse description or horse payment and total payment for entries. Emailing entries is helpful however this will not be considered an official entry.
- The Closing Date is the date in which the program will be published and any changes after the closing date will not be in the official program and will be hand written in at the coaches meeting.
- The closing date for the show is (March 26, 2021)
- In the event you have a scratch prior to the closing date, use the attached *Pre-Closing Date Refund Request Form* to ensure a full refund. Remember, this document needs to completed in its entirety AND **received** by the show secretary by 5:00pm of the closing date to ensure a refund.
- Entry fees for scratches occurring after the closing date/time, will be refunded only under extraordinary circumstances. If you feel your rider/s circumstances rise to this level, you may complete a *Post-Closing Date Refund Request Form* located under *Coaches Forms* on the YEDA Website. Your request will be reviewed and voted on the first scheduled meeting following its receipt. You will be notified of the results within two business days of the vote. In the event a refund is to be issued, a check will be mailed within two weeks of the vote.
- As noted in the Covid-19 plan above, if you are feeling ill or have been exposed to Covid-19, please stay at home. If you are running a temperature over 100.4°F, prior to attending the horse show, please stay at home. Refunds will be given to those suspected of having or being exposed to Covid-19.

#### **Substitutions**

Substitutions will be permitted providing they comply with ALL the below mentioned parameters:

- Same Day
- Same Division
- Same Class

#### Payment

- Please make checks payable to Royal Creek Equestrian Team
- Any 'Adds' must be accompanied by payment
- When possible, please avoid writing multiple checks.

#### Rent and/or Provide a Horse

One horse is required for every six rides. For example, one rider competing in both rail and pattern class will equal two rides.

## Per Rule 13.05 Horses that are considered height weight horses as defined (R17.01) will only be eligible to cover 4 rides.

If you are unable to provide enough horses to meet the needs of your entries, you may rent rides at the cost of \$30 each.

#### Height/Weight:

Please take note the height/weight notification box. The show committee will follow the YEDA rulebook suggestion for Height/Weight riders. The limits for slight/older horses will be 5'9" – 160#. Height weight for Horses/Ponies 13.3 to 14.2 it is 5'5" – 135#. If the rider exceeds these either of these limits please mark the appropriate check box on the entry form. This will bring the rider to attention so that the riders height and weight can be observed in the database.

This same column is also offered on the **horse description page to note which horses need to be height/weight horses**. Horses who are height/weight horses are horses whom it is bad for their health or carry a rider of a size greater than 5'9" and/or 160#. Or a horse/pony between the size of 13.3 – 14.2, will have the limits of 5'5" – 135#.

#### **Diamond Elite**

The Diamond Elite class will be offered at this horse show. Teams who qualify to participate will be based on the top 8 teams who are attending the show according to the posted online points as of the entry due date. Those teams will receive and email invitation before the show explaining that they have qualified to participate in the Diamond Elite class. If a team who has qualified chooses not to participate then the invitation will be offered to the team in in line according to points as of the due date of the show.

Entries for the Diamond Elite will be accepted at the show, with full payment.

Additionally, Exhibitors agree to defend and hold YEDA, its directors, official, employees, and all persons, stables, and/or other entities providing facilities, horses or equipment for YEDA Shows and activities (hereinafter collectively referred to as "YEDA & Affiliates"), harmless for any claim action, or suit, including claim, action, or suit for injury, property damage, or death sustained during participation in the show by the entity, his/her coach, trainer or visitors.

Furthermore, Exhibitors hereby acknowledge and recognize that competing in YEDA and event and/or show is an inherently dangerous activity and may result in substantial and serious injury, including but not limited to, maiming, paralysis, and/or death, and that all of the aforementioned individuals openly and freely accept all of the potential risks association with participation in YEDA events/shows. Accordingly Exhibitors agree to waive, release, and hold harmless the YEDA & Affiliates from any and all actions, causes of action, suits, debts, promises, damages, judgments, claims, and/or demands whatsoever, in law and/or equity. In making entry into YEDA Competition or event, team and/or individuals explicitly indemnify YEDA & Affiliates from the same.

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
