#### TIE BREAKING RULES

#### **Two Judge Scoring**

#### Combining Judges' Cards for the overall Placings:

The multiple judge system used for combining the judges' cards for the overall placings is a modified version of the AQHA Multiple Judge System found in the AQHA Rulebook. Judges will place the class independently, placing all riders on their card. Each placing will then be given a numerical score and then these scores are combined to determine the overall placings. See chart below for the numerical scores for each placing.

#### Tie Breaking Rules

#### Class Ties:

In the event of a tie in a class, it will be broken by the tiebreaker judges' card, not the score sheet. Judge A will break all odd numbered classes, and Judge B will break all even numbered classes.

#### **High Point Rider Ties:**

In the event of a tie in the individual high point rider competition, the tie will be broken by a horse knowledge question asked by the appointed judge. The tie breaker judge for the High School High Point Rider is Judge A. The tie breaker judge for the Junior High School High Point Rider will be broken by Judge B.

#### **Top 10 Team Placement Ties**

#### Tie Breaking Rules:

In the event of a tie in the team standings, the tie will be broken by the team with the most number of first places, if still tied then the team with the most number of second places, if still tied this pattern will continue for 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup> places.

In the event this method does not break the tie; the high school team tie will be broken by the team who placed the highest in Diamond Rail/Pattern Team Horsemanship. The junior high tie will be then broken by the highest placing team in the Sapphire Rail Horsemanship. If neither team have a rider in the aforementioned class, then the tie will be broken using the next lower division rail horsemanship.


#### NRHA PATTERN 3



- 1.Beginning, lope straight up the left side of the arena, circle the top end of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from the walls or fence, run straight down the opposite or right side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback—no hesitation.
- 2.Continue straight up the right side of the arena circle back around the top of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from the walls or fence, run straight down the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback—no hesitation.
- 3.Continue up the left side of the arena to the center marker. At the center marker, the horse should be on the right lead. Guide the horse to the center of the arena on the right lead and complete three circles to the right: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 4.Complete three circles to the left: the first two circles large and fast; the third circle small and slow. Change leads in the center of the arena.
- 5.Begin a large circle to the right but do not close this circle. Continue up the left side of the arena, circle the top of the arena, and staying at least twenty feet (six meters) from the walls or fence, run straight down the opposite or right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Back up at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.
- 6.Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
- 7. Complete four spins to the left. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.



#### **NRHA PATTERN 9**



- 1.Run past the center marker and do a sliding stop. Backup to the center of the arena or at least ten feet (three meters). Hesitate.
- 2.Complete four spins to the right. Hesitate.
- 3. Complete four and one-quarter spins to the left so that horse is facing the left wall or fence. Hesitate.
- 4.Beginning on the left lead, complete three circles to the left: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of thearena.
- 5. Complete three circles to the right: the first circle small and slow; the next two circles large and fast. Change leads at the center of the arena.
- 6.Begin a large circle to the left but do not close this circle. Run up the right side of the arena past the center marker and do a right rollback at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
- 7. Continue back around the previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up the left side of the arena past the center marker and do a left rollback at least twenty feet(six meters) from the wall or fence—no hesitation.
- 8.Continue back around previous circle but do not close this circle. Run up right side of the arena past the center marker and do a sliding stop at least twenty feet (six meters) from the wall or fence. Hesitate to demonstrate completion of the pattern.



## HORSE DESCRIPTIONS

**Jess**: (MH) Does all maneuvers very well. Rides with light bit contact. Can get quick in the run down to stops. Rider can wear spurs.

**Grinder**: (MH) Does all maneuvers well, needs to be pushed into bridle and supported to stops. Otherwise, he will front end his stops. Light contact on bit and guided with riders legs.

**Bob:** (MH) Reiner, Good Draw, Nice Rollback and Spins. NO SPURS. Rider should use upper leg to cue for lead changes. Very responsive to rider cues.

**Forrest**: (Arnold) Light rein contact. Rowel or ball spur depending on division. Use hand and leg to support into lope transition and to collect on rail. Has spur stop for patterns.

Freddie: (Arnold) Good Draw. Light contact. Walk trot classes only

**Rocky**: (Arnold) Light rein contact. No Spurs. May anticipate on patterns. Just don't rush him in transitions. No Spurs. Let horse holder put numbers in number holders HATES to have his flank area touched. Great to ride. Great Draw. Great walk/trot horse.

**Sissy**: (Arnold) Light rein contact. Support with hand and use leg to collect. Needs to be set up for right lead. Hand to rail and push hip in. Ball spurs optional.

Emmett: (BayHill) sorrel gelding, can be lazy, keep bridled, spurs or crop.

**Danny:** (BayHill) sorrel gelding, light contact. If you hold too tight he won't go forward. Set up for leads, no spurs.

**Bella**: (Bayhill) Good Spins. Good lead changes. Will get restless in the middle so don't stand very long, she will get hot if you try to run her too hard. Spurs ok

Ginger: (BayHill) sorrel mare, great draw, light contact. Set up for leads, spurs or crop

**Sly:** (BayHill) Bay Gelding, set up for leads. Smooth lope and trot. Can go without spurs. Great Pattern Horse, Reiner

**Hope:** (Champion Hill) Consistent, Keep on the Rail always the same horse. Good with voice. Will start dropping her shoulder as day goes on. NO SPURS

**Stan:** (EQD) Sorrel POA Gelding. Ht/Wt Horse - Can get quick, hold with quiet rein. Set up for leads. May need spurs later day.

Sarah: (EQD) Sorrel Paint Mare. Spurs optional. Ride with light contact. Will drift to inside if allowed.

**Junior**: (EQD) Bay QH Gelding. Ranch type horse, has some reining training. Responds quickly off of cues. Will go slow if asked but need to keep in the bridle. Set up for right lead. Spurs ok

**Cooper:** (EQD) Brown Paint Gelding, Steer with legs. Adjust speed with reins. Lope can get big. No Spurs.

Izzy: (Hancock) No spurs, Ranch type mover with lots of drive don't pick a fight with her face. Wrap your legs around her to support her forward will work best with being asked to respond instead of told to react avoid sharp demands with legs



## HORSE DESCRIPTIONS

**Milo:** (Hancock) For Reining: keep him bridled up and focused. Ride through your lead changes, easy spins, will run off into stops if you let him make him wait to build speed sit down with weight forward in feet to stop. For Horsemanship: Lazy, will jog for W/T but level appropriate spurs for lope classes keep him forward in his lope to get true gait

**Gator:** (Hancock) Quiet-lazy will be good for W/T but use level appropriate spurs for lope classes very honest good draw don't trap his face

Bree: (Hancock) No spurs, slow smooth ride, light rein contact, set up for right lead

**Fiat:** (Hancock) No spurs, Ranch type, lopes with a lot of drive but not a lot of speed she will break if you quit riding. Set up for leads

**Chester:** (Hancock) Chestnut Quarter Horse Gelding. Good draw. Stay relaxed on him. Can ride with light contact. Easy draw and great pattern horse. Squeeze to slow down and kiss to lope off. Talk to him when you stop and break down to trot or walk. Ball spurs preferred but can use rowel.

**Remi:** (Hancock) Sorrel Quarter Horse Mare. Good draw. Ride with light contact. Has a leg release stop. Set up for leads. Great pattern horse. To slow down release your legs off of her, but not so much she will stop. Do not squeeze to slow her down, it will make her go faster. Ball spurs only.

**Pride:** (Hickory Ridge) Black Paint Gelding, No Spurs. Prefers to be ridder with some contact. Responds best to leg contact.

**Grace:** (KCPH) This mare will ride well if you use your legs. Spur Stop, Division appropriate spurs allowed. Rides best with little to no contact.

**Dusty:** (KCPH) - He is a leg horse. Rides best with little to no contact in the bridle. Spur Stop. Division appropriate spurs allowed. Will lope sideways if you push too hard with one leg.

**Raider:** (KCPH) Walk/Jog Only. Power steering, has a spur stop, so squeeze to stop. He also responds well to verbal cues. Great Draw.

**Bud:** (McColley) Spur stop, light contact; has lead change so watch legs during lope; No Spurs except for the diamond elite class, but not needed for Walk Trot. Good Draw. Nice Pattern Horse!

**Jake**: (McColley) Medium Contact; Spurs recommended, keep a soft leg, leg release stop, responds to voice commands, do not use in patterns with spins. Don't trap him in reverse. Good Draw. Keep his attention, he can get distracted.


**Tuffy**: (McColley) Spurs recommended, setup for right lead, leg release to stop, light contact, will jog and lope slow but you have to make him and it requires a lot of leg, responds to voice command. Requires leg contact at the lope. Can have contact if leg is there to back it up. Good Draw. Set up for Right Lead.

**Suzie:** (McColley) Light to medium contact (do not overbridle!). Ball spurs or no spurs depending on division, spur trained, responds well to and recommend using voice commands, very quiet slow loper, can be crabby if passed too closely, DO NOT ADJUST GIRTH, appropriate for all divisions, will excel more in rail vs pattern classes



## HORSE DESCRIPTIONS

Corcha: (M&M) Reining type, can go slow on the rail. Spurs Ok Very lazy.

**Jay:** (M&M) more pleasure type but without the spur stop. Need to encourage a slow walk. Very easy loper and jogger

**Travis:** (Puthoff) Very Good Draw, No Spurs (may change to Ball Spurs later in the day, check with the steward.) Light legs, set up for leads. He knows lead changes. Once loping don't use much leg. Don't be tight with legs.

Dawg: (Puthoff) Reiner & Horsemanship, No Spurs in AM, Ball Spurs or Dull Spurs in PM (Division Appropriate). LOTS of calf for lead changes. Set up for Leads, especially the right lead.

**Zip:** (Puthoff) Quiet, Easy Draw. Ball Spurs or Rowel Spurs (Division Appropriate). Lazy. Rough at Canter.

**Rosie:** (Royal Creek) (Saturday Only) Sorrel mare QH- retired show horse. great draw, kiss and push opposite leg to lope, cluck to trot. Works off of leg pressure to pivot. Can use any spurs or no spurs

**Coco:** (Southern Ohio) Bay Gelding, use quiet hands, light contact, use lots of leg, cluck for jog and kiss for lope, will respond to spur stop or neck rein, spurs according to division.

**Ruby:** (Southern Ohio) Appaloosa Mare, (red roan look) light contact, heavy leg, cluck for jog and kiss for lope, set up for leads. Spur according to division.

**Pokey:** (Southern Ohio) Sorrel Quarter Horse, lots of leg, light hands, click to jog, kiss to lope, move reins to neck for transitions. Spurs appropriate to class.

**Stu:** (Southern Ohio) Sorrel Gelding, good draw, quiet, takes leads, cluck for jog, kiss for lope, along with leg. Very light rein contact. Spurs according to division rules.

Rawhide: (Timmerman's) (Wt Horse due to age #175) Older Horse, VERY QUIET! 16 hands tall. Great for walk/trot! No Spurs, No Crop!

**Big Shot:** (Timmerman's) 15' 3 hand gelding, steady eddie horse. Great Draw. Set up for right lead, turn head until he has picked up the lead. No Spurs, No Crop!

**River:** (Triple Edge) Arab Very willing to work. Can wear spurs but ok with none. Need to stay light in his mouth. Will collect with leg pressure. Is spur trained. For pattern work he will get nervous at the first cone but if you don't make him wait he is great for patterns. Just need to stay quite with him at the start for pattern work. Weight Horse #175

**Rolf:** (Triple Edge) Fjord Gelding, He is spur trained. Very easy will do what you ask him. Can keep him bridled but also ok on a looser rein. Height 5'7"

**Manny:** (Arthur) Light contact on his face, protect his leads <u>especially</u> in patterns. Very light leg in patterns. Pull to slow down. Spur stop. Spurs in appropriate divisions rowels are fine. VERY GOOD DRAW

**Shorty:** (Arthur) Height Weight Height/Weight #175 and 5'7" No spurs ride, ranch horse type ride with Light contact not a drape rain ride off the rail can get looky. Let her walk out at the walk, rider choose her speed for jog and lope, very sensitive, light leg and hands.
