

Entry Information, Deadlines, and Scratch Refund Policy:

Entries will not be accepted without payment.

- Open date for entries February 5, 2024
- The due date for entries is March 7, 2024
 - It is suggested to send entries in ASAP, shows can fill up fast!
- Entries received after the due date may not be accepted.

Junior High – Senior High – Non-Team Entries

- This is an *INFLATION BUSTER SHOW* which means, which means that entry fees are reduced by half for the second judge. The total cost is \$75 per class. This includes an office fee and the entry fees for both judges.
 - ONE JUDGE: \$45 entry fee + \$5 Office Fee
 - SECOND JUDGE: \$22.50 entry free + \$2.50 Office Fee
 - For a total of \$75 per class for both judges. This is the entry fee and office fee.
- The office fee will not be refunded in the event of a pre or post close date scratch.

EWD Entries

- This is an *INFLATION BUSTER SHOW* which means, which means that entry fees are reduced <u>EWD Entries are a total of \$60 for each class</u>, this includes entry free and office fee. Office fee is \$7.50 per class for both judges.
 - This takes into the consideration the inflation buster shows trend of this horse show and includes the discount of the second class that is the trend at regular shows all season.
 - For simple accounting we have made EACH EWD class \$60 per show. This covers both judges. In the event of only needing ONE judge the Fee is \$50 per Judge.
- Note: rented ride fees will not be refunded after the close date.
- R40.04 Number of Entries and Limiting Entries <u>No show should exceed 250 rides per day.</u> Entries will be accepted on a first come basis. Meaning that entries will only be considered accepted once originals are received with horse description or horse payment and total payment for entries. Emailing entries is helpful however this will not be considered an official entry.
 <u>Teams are limited to 42 total entries between Jr and Sr high teams</u>. EWD, Pearl and 64 Alumni entries do not count toward the total number of entries (R1.01 B) Show committees may accept additional entries in the Jr and Sr high divisions from one team if the show has not exceeded the maximum number of entries by closing date.
- If the maximum entries are reached, entries will be accepted on a first come basis. Meaning that entries will only be considered accepted once originals are received with horse description or horse payment and total payment for entries. Emailing entries is helpful however this will not be considered an official entry.
- The Closing Date is the date in which the program will be published and any changes after the closing date will not be in the official program and will be hand written in at the coaches meeting.
- The closing date for the show is March 14, 2024

- In the event you have a scratch prior to the closing date, use the <u>Scratch and Refund Request</u> <u>Form</u> to ensure a full refund. Remember, this document needs to be completed in its entirety AND **received** by the show secretary by 5:00pm of the closing date to ensure a refund.
- Entry fees for scratches occurring after the closing date/time, will be refunded only under extraordinary circumstances. If you feel your rider/s circumstances rise to this level, you may complete a <u>Scratch and Refund Request Form</u> located under *Coaches Forms* on the YEDA Website.

Substitutions will be permitted providing they comply with ALL the below mentioned parameters:

Rent and/or Provide a Horse

One horse is required for every six rides. For example, one rider competing in both rail and pattern class will equal two rides.

Per Rule 12.05 C Split Combined Show: Teams are required to bring one (1) horse for every nine (9) entries, unless the host team reduces the team's horse entry ratio because of space or entry limits. Horses that are considered height weight horses as defined (R16.01-C) will only be eligible to cover six (6) entries.

Rented ride fees are not refunded after the close date.

If you are unable to provide enough horses to meet the needs of your entries, you may rent rides at the cost of **\$40 each.**

Height/Weight:

Please take note the height/weight notification box. The show committee will follow the YEDA rulebook suggestion for Height/Weight riders. The limits for slight/older horses will be 5'9" – 160#. Height weight for Horses/Ponies 13.3 to 14.2 it is 5'5" – 135#. If the rider exceeds these either of these limits please mark the appropriate check box on the entry form. This will bring the rider to attention so that the riders height and weight can be observed in the database.

This same column is also offered on the **horse description page to note which horses need to be height/weight horses**. Horses who are height/weight horses are horses whom it is bad for their health or carry a rider of a size greater than 5'9" and/or 160#. Or a horse/pony between the size of 13.3 – 14.2, will have the limits of 5'5" – 135#.

The Diamond Elite class will be offered at this horse show. Teams who qualify to participate will be based on the top teams who are attending the show according to the posted online points as of the entry due date (December 30, 2023). Those teams will receive an email invitation before the show explaining that they have qualified to participate in the Diamond Elite class. If a team who has qualified chooses not to participate then the invitation will be offered to the team in in line according to points as of the due date of the show.
