

Qualifications and Requirements

ALL INFORMATION MUST BE SENT IN ITS ENTIRETY TO BE CONSIDERED FOR THE AWARD(S)

- 1. Must be a junior or senior enrolled in a high school program, moving on to undergraduate, apprentice, or work training program. Applicant must explain or verify their intentions in writing.
- 2. Eligible applicants must have completed at least 150 hours (for Senior applicants) or 100 hours (for Junior applications) of community service in the past three years. Include organized documentation.
- **3.** Actively participate in the equestrian community, include organized documentation.
- **4.** Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50.
- 5. Special consideration given to seniors showing intention of attending an NCAA or IHSA college or university and participating on that college or university's equestrian team. <u>Junior Scholarship applicants do not have to have an intended college or university selected.</u>
- 6. Students must have verification of their grade point average from their high school registrar. Please include a copy of your transcript with your application packet.
- 7. Must be a current member in good standing with YEDA.
- **8.** Enclose a letter from your YEDA coach verifying that you have been on the team for at least one show season.
- 9. Submit two written letters of recommendation stating why you should be considered for this scholarship; these should be enclosed in the packet.
- 10. Be able to describe the following: What it means to me to be an equestrian. Using both a 500-word essay and a Power Point or similar media to express your thoughts. Both need to be printed and enclosed in the packet.
- 11. Applicants must include all the following information in the mailed packet, or this application will be considered incomplete. Please PRINT all documents and include in packet.
 - Application Form
 - Official High School Transcript
 - Verification letter from team coach or team advisor
 - Two letters of recommendation
 - Essay and Power Point or similar media
- 12. All completed packages must be postmarked on or before April 1st.
- 13. The Senior Achievement Award Committee will announce all scholarship recipients by June 1st.
- **14.** All applicants agree upon submission that your essay and media presentation could be used by YEDA.
