Entry Information, Deadlines, and Scratch Refund Policy:

Entries will not be accepted without payment.

- Open date for entries August 3, 2025
- The due date for entries is August 25, 2025
 - It is suggested to send entries in ASAP, shows can fill up fast!
- Entries received after the due date may not be accepted.
- Entries are **\$45** per class plus a \$5 office fee per class. **For a total of \$50 per class.** The off fee will not be refunded in the event of a pre or post close date scratch.
- EWD Entries are **\$35** per class plus a \$5 office fee per class. **For a total of \$40 per class.** The office fee will not be refunded in the event of a pre or post close date scratch.
- Note: rented ride fees will not be refunded after the close date.
 - R40.04 Number of Entries and Limiting Entries <u>Due to the arena size this show will not</u> <u>exceed 180 rides per day</u>. Entries will be accepted on a first-come basis. Meaning that entries will only be considered accepted once originals are received with horse description or horse payment and total payment for entries. Emailing entries is helpful, however this will not be considered an official entry. <u>Teams are limited to 42 total entries between Jr and Sr high</u> <u>teams</u>. EWD, Pearl and Alumni entries do not count toward the total number of entries (R1.01 B) Show committees may accept additional entries in the Jr and Sr high divisions from teams if the show has not exceeded the maximum number of entries by closing date. As long as it is done in a fair and equitable way.
 - In the event that the maximum entries are reached entries will be accepted on a first come basis. Meaning that entries will only be considered accepted once originals are received with horse description or horse payment and total payment for entries. Emailed entries are considered official entries, once the payment has been received.
 - The Closing Date is the date in which the program will be published and any changes after the closing date will not be in the official program and will be handwritten in at the coaches meeting.
 - The closing date for the show is September 8,2025
 - In the event you have a scratch prior to the closing date, use the <u>Scratch and Refund Request</u> <u>Form</u> to ensure a full refund. Remember, this document needs to completed in its entirety AND received by the show secretary by 5:00pm of the closing date to ensure a refund.
 - Entry fees for scratches occurring after the closing date/time, will be refunded only under extraordinary circumstances. If you feel your rider/s circumstances rise to this level, you may complete a <u>Scratch and Refund Request Form</u> located under *Coaches Forms* on the YEDA Website.

Rent and/or Provide a Horse

R12.05 Horse ratio requirements per type of show:

Single Day Show: Teams are required to bring **one (1) horse for every six (6)**, unless the host team reduces the team's horse entry ratio because of space or entry limits. Horses that are considered height weight horses as defined (R16.01-B & C). Show management, when necessary, has the discretion to reduce the number of entries/rides height weight horses to less than 6.

One horse is required for every six rides. For example, one rider competing in both rail and pattern class will equal two rides.

It is suggested at rented ride fees are not refunded after the close date.

If you are unable to provide enough horses to meet the needs of your entries, you may rent rides at the cost of **\$50** each.

Height/Weight:

Please take note the **height/weight** notification box. The show committee will follow the YEDA rulebook (R16.01-B & C) suggestion for Height/Weight riders. The limits for **slight/older horses will be 5'9" – 160#.** Height weight for **Horses/Ponies 12.3 to 14.2 it is 5'5" – 125#.** If the rider exceeds these either of these limits please mark the appropriate check box on the entry form. This will bring the rider to attention so that the riders height and weight can be observed in the database.

This same column is also offered on the **horse description page to note which horses need to be height/weight horses**. Horses who are height/weight horses are horses whom it is bad for their health or carry a rider of a size greater than 5'9" and/or 160#. Or a horse/pony between the size of **12.3 to 14.2**, will have the limits of **5'5" – 125#.**

Diamond Elite

The Diamond Elite class mayl be offered at this horse show. Teams who qualify to participate will be based on the top <u>(2,4,6,8 host gets to choose how large you want the class to be)</u> teams who are attending the show according to the posted online points as of the entry due date <u>(add date)</u>. Those teams will receive and email invitation before the show explaining that they have qualified to participate in the Diamond Elite class. If a team who has qualified chooses not to participate then the invitation will be offered to the team in in line according to points as of the due date of the show.

Entries for the Diamond Elite will be accepted at the show, with full payment.
